BOARD OF CURATORS' ACTIONS

Jefferson City, MO- During its meeting on September 13, 2012 the Lincoln University Board of Curators took the following actions:

1. Approved the following revision to Section 2.51 of Bylaws and Rules of Procedure of the Lincoln University Board of Curators Bylaws:

2.51 Absent Members:

A curator may participate in a regular scheduled meeting via video or audio conferencing. When a curator participates via video or audio conferencing, all votes will be taken by roll call. Curators may use this privilege not to exceed two (2) meetings per year.

2. Approved revisions to Section 3.12.1 – Guidelines for Grants and Contracts – Lincoln University Rules and Regulations:
 - A. Revision to section 3.12.1: Guidelines for Grants and Contracts;
 - B. Remove section 3.33: Grant Reassigned Time and Salary Adjustment;
 - C. Remove the entire paragraph in section 8.12.1, which reads: Salary Guidelines for Grants.

3. Approved the following Policy – Graduate Academic Probation/ Suspension:

Graduate Academic Probation/Suspension Policy

A graduate student whose cumulative graduate GPA falls below 3.000 will be placed on academic probation. While on academic probation, a graduate student may not enroll in more than 6 credits per semester or summer session. No student will be allowed to take the comprehensive examination while on academic probation. A graduate student who is currently on academic probation will be suspended for one semester if he/she fails to restore his/her cumulative GPA to 3.000 or earn a term GPA of 3.500. A graduate student who earns a term GPA of 3.500 but fails to restore his/her cumulative GPA to 3.000 can enroll the following semester on continued academic probation. A graduate student will be dismissed from the graduate program if he/she incurs a second graduate academic suspension. Appeals for reinstatement can be made to the Graduate Council who will make a recommendation to the Vice President of Academic Affairs who will make the final decision. Appeals for reinstatement should have the support of the graduate advisor and appropriate department head.

4. Approved a revision to the Lincoln University FY13 General Operating Budget. The total revised General fund budget request is \$35,824,585. The revised budget is based on additional state appropriation withholdings received after the June Board of Curators' meeting.
