



Moodle is a Web-based learning management and collaboration portal that enables educators to manage course materials and to communicate with students. Moodle can function both as a complement to traditional courses and as a site for distance learning.

With Moodle, you can give surveys, quizzes, and tests; send and receive course mail; post messages to threaded discussions and chat rooms; upload assignments using online drop boxes; and more. You input students' progress and grades at any time during a course. You can also create groups and teams for project or committee work.

As a faculty member you should receive training on this learning management system by your department head or by attending scheduled training through the Center for Innovation Instruction in Martin Luther King Hall.
