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Executive Summary

Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey (GSS) Data Analysis for Academic Years 2004-2006

Introduction:

The Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey (GSS), a locally developed, 40-item survey, is designed to provide student feedback regarding the quality of educational programs, services, and overall student experience at Lincoln University. The survey is divided into four sections. Section 1 (survey items 1-10) collects background and demographic information. Section 2 (survey items 11-20) asks students to rate the degree to which their college education has contributed to their knowledge, skills, and/or personal development in several areas using the following scale: A=Very Much; B=Somewhat; C=Very Little; and D=Not At All. Section 3 (survey items 21-37) asks students to rate their satisfaction with various aspects of their LU education using the following scale: A=Very Satisfied; B=Satisfied; C=Dissatisfied and D=Very Dissatisfied. Section 4 (survey items 38-40) asks students to answer general questions regarding their attendance at LU. To maximize response rate, the survey is administered to students in conjunction with the Major Field Test during Assessment Week in the fall and spring semesters. The Education Department, Nursing Department, and the Office of Graduate Studies also assist with administering the GSS to their respective graduates, thus, students completing the survey are primarily graduating students.

The Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey (GSS) Data Analysis, prepared by the Center for Assessment, Institutional Research and Planning, provides information regarding the students that have completed the GSS during academic years 2004, 2005 and 2006. All information used to complete this analysis was obtained from the GSS database that is maintained by Lincoln University's Assessment Coordinator.

Methodology:

The GSS was administered to a total of 786 students during academic year 2004 (172 students), 2005 (284 students) and 2006 (330 students). Of those students completing the survey during academic year 2004, 39.5% were male, 59.3% were female and 1.2% did not indicate their gender. Of those students completing the survey during academic year 2005, 37.0% were male, 62.3% were female and .7% did not indicate their gender. Of those students completing the survey during academic year 2006, 31.8% were male, 67.6% were female and .6% did not indicate their gender.

Data Analysis:

In order to provide Lincoln University with the most useful information, data in the GSS database was analyzed using two different methods. Section 1 reports the results of the first method: comparison of the percentage of respondents that completed the GSS during academic years 2004, 2005 and 2006. Tables 1-14 (pages 1-12) provide summaries of this analysis. Section 2 reports the results of the second method: comparison of the mean of survey items 11-37. To complete this section, the survey scales were changed to a 4-point Likert-scale and a mean was computed for each survey item for each academic year. For questions 11-20, Survey scale A=Very Much was changed to 4; Survey scale B=Somewhat was changed to 3; Survey scale C=Very Little was changed to 2 and Survey Scale D=Not At All was changed to 1. For questions 21-37, Survey scale A=Very Satisfied was changed to 4; Survey Scale B=Satisfied was changed to 3; Survey scale C=Dissatisfied was changed to 2 and Survey scale D=Very Dissatisfied was changed to 1. Tables 55-61 (pages 53-57) provide summaries of this analysis.

Findings:

Section 1: Comparison of Percentages

Analysis of the contribution items (survey items 11-20) reveals that GSS respondents for academic years 2004 and 2005 believe their LU education has contributed the most to their ability to write clearly and logically, ability to give effective oral presentations, ability to work with others in a group, leadership skills, and ability to work with people from diverse backgrounds while the GSS respondents for academic year 2006 believe their LU education has contributed the most to their ability to write clearly and logically, openness to new ideas and practices, ability to work with others in a group, leadership skills, and ability to work with people from diverse backgrounds. GSS respondents for academic years 2004 and 2005 believe their LU education has contributed the least to their openness to new ideas, understanding and appreciation of other cultures, tolerance of people with different beliefs, ability to use computer technology, and awareness of global issues and events while GSS respondents for academic year 2006 believe their LU education has contributed the least to their ability to give effective oral presentations, understanding and appreciation of other cultures, tolerance of people with different beliefs, ability to use computer technology and awareness of global issues and events. Analysis of the satisfaction items (survey items 21-37) reveals that GSS respondents for all three academic years are most satisfied with their academic major, interaction with faculty in or out of class, instruction in their major courses, professional competence of faculty in their major, instruction in elective courses and overall quality of their education. This analysis also reveals that GSS respondents for academic years 2004 and 2005 are least satisfied with availability of courses required for their degree, sense of "belonging" at this university, preparation for the job market and career advisement while GSS respondents for academic year 2006 are least satisfied with academic advising, sense of "belonging" at this university, preparation for the job market and career advisement. See Tables 12, 13 and 14 on pages 11 and 12 for a summary of this analysis. On subsequent pages, results are broken down by individual survey items and are displayed graphically.

Section 2: Comparison of Means

Analysis of the contribution items (survey items 11-20) reveals that ability to work with people from diverse backgrounds, ability to write clearly and logically, openness to new ideas and practices, ability to work with others in a group, understanding and appreciation of other cultures, and ability to give effective oral presentations generated the highest means for academic years 2004 and 2005 while ability to work with people from diverse backgrounds, ability to write clearly and logically, openness to new ideas and practices, ability to work with others in a group and leadership skills generated the highest means for academic year 2006. This analysis also reveals that tolerance of people with different beliefs, leadership skills, ability to use computer technology, and awareness of global issues and events generated the lowest means for both academic years 2004 and 2005 while tolerance of people with different beliefs, ability to give effective oral presentations, ability to use computer technology and awareness of global issues and events generated the lowest means for academic year 2006. Findings:

Section 2: Comparison of Means continued

Analysis of the satisfaction items (survey items 21-37) reveals that academic major, interaction with faculty in or out of class, professional competence of faculty in major, and instruction in major courses generated the highest means for all three academic years while preparation for the job market, sense of "belonging" at this university, and career advisement generated the lowest means for all three academic years. See Tables 59, 60 and 61 on pages 56 and 57 for a summary of this analysis. On subsequent pages, results are broken down by individual survey items and are displayed graphically.

Conclusions and Recommendations:

The students that complete the GSS are not a representative sample of the entire student body; therefore, the results of this analysis cannot be generalized to the entire student population. This analysis; however, has identified emerging patterns that are present regardless of the analysis method employed: GSS respondents believe that their LU education has contributed the least to their knowledge, skills, and/or personal development in the following areas: tolerance of people with different beliefs, ability to use computer technology, and awareness of global issues and events; and GSS respondents are least satisfied with preparation for the job market, sense of "belonging" at this university, and career advisement. The CAIRP recommends the continued administration of the GSS and analysis of the data collected to determine if future analyses will yield the same results.

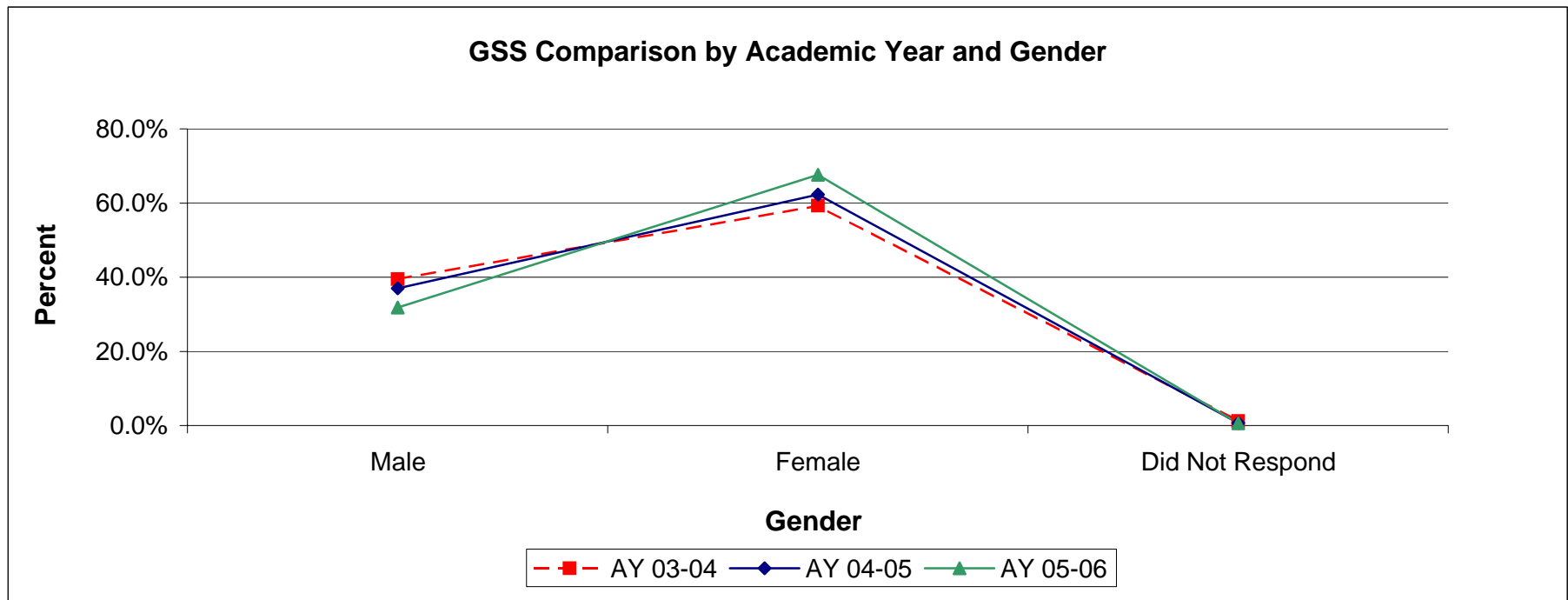

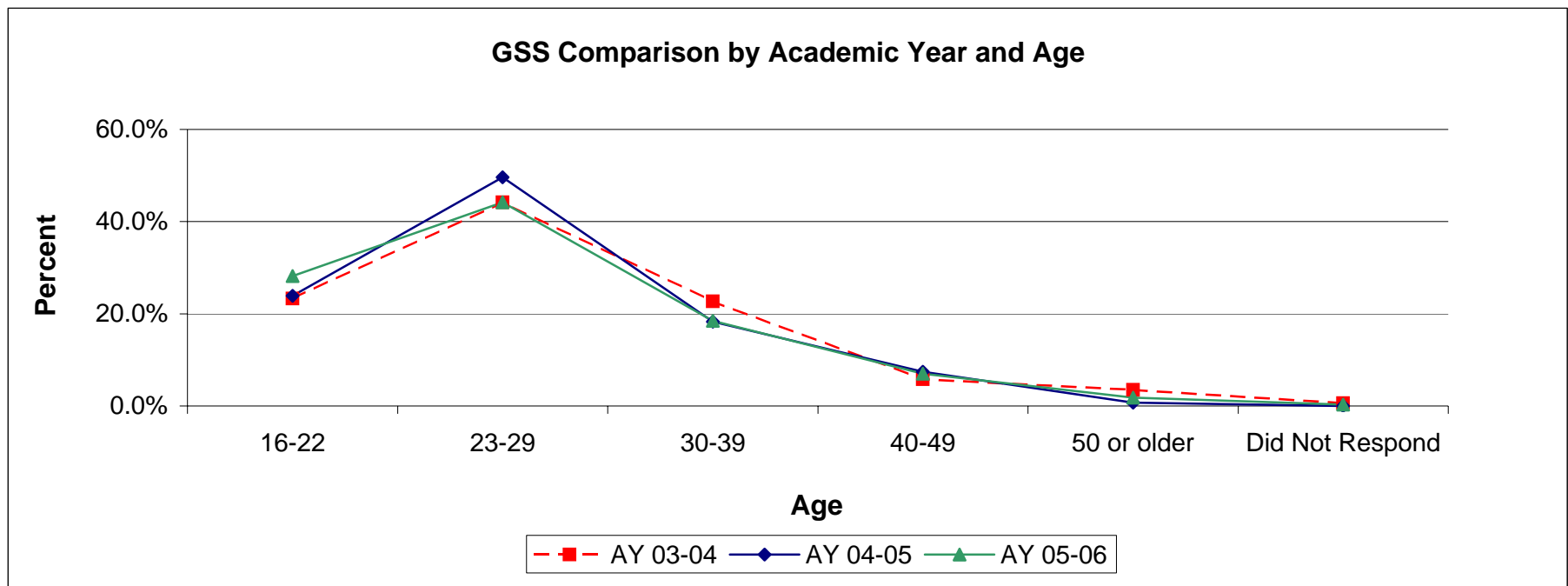


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Age

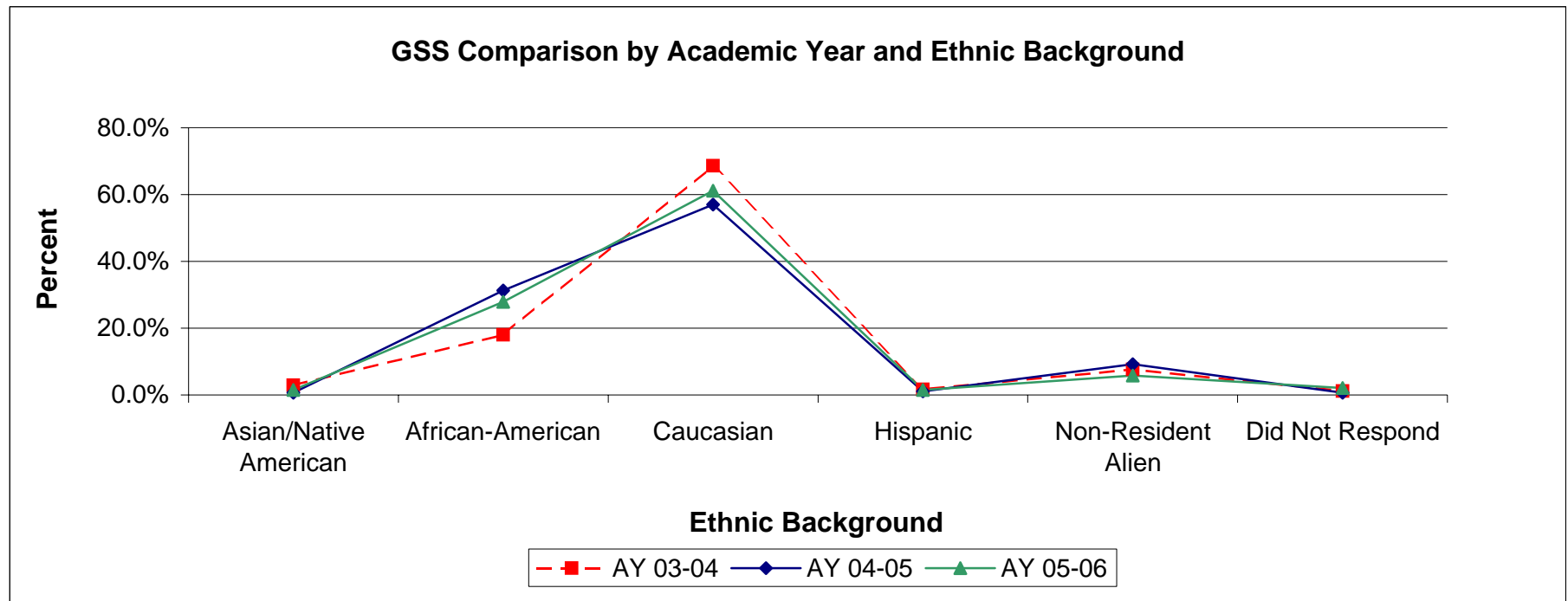


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Ethnic Background

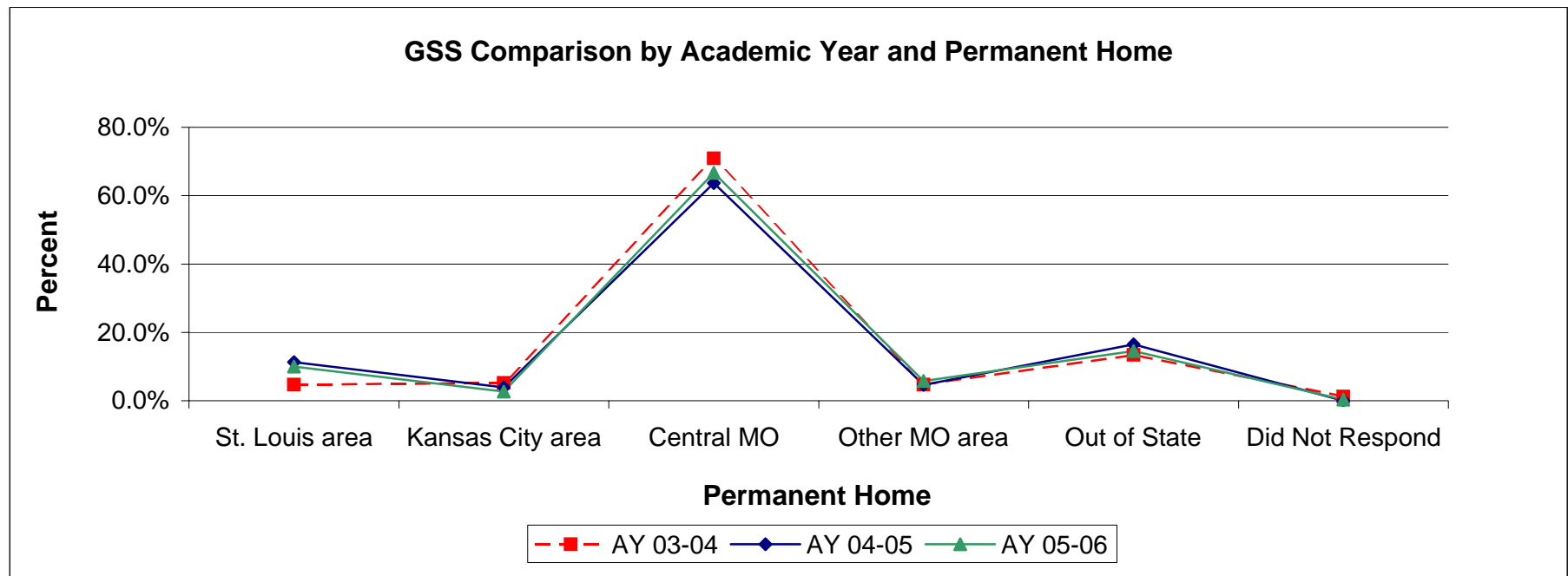


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Permanent Home

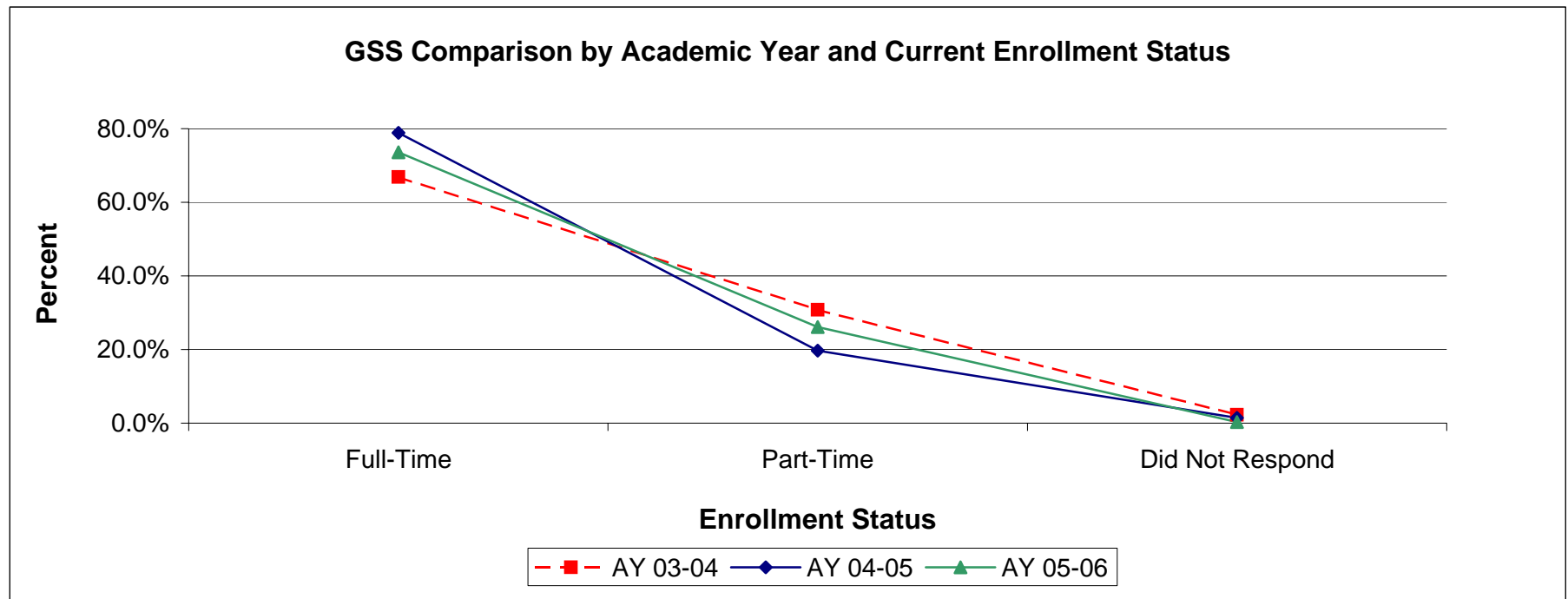


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Current Enrollment Status

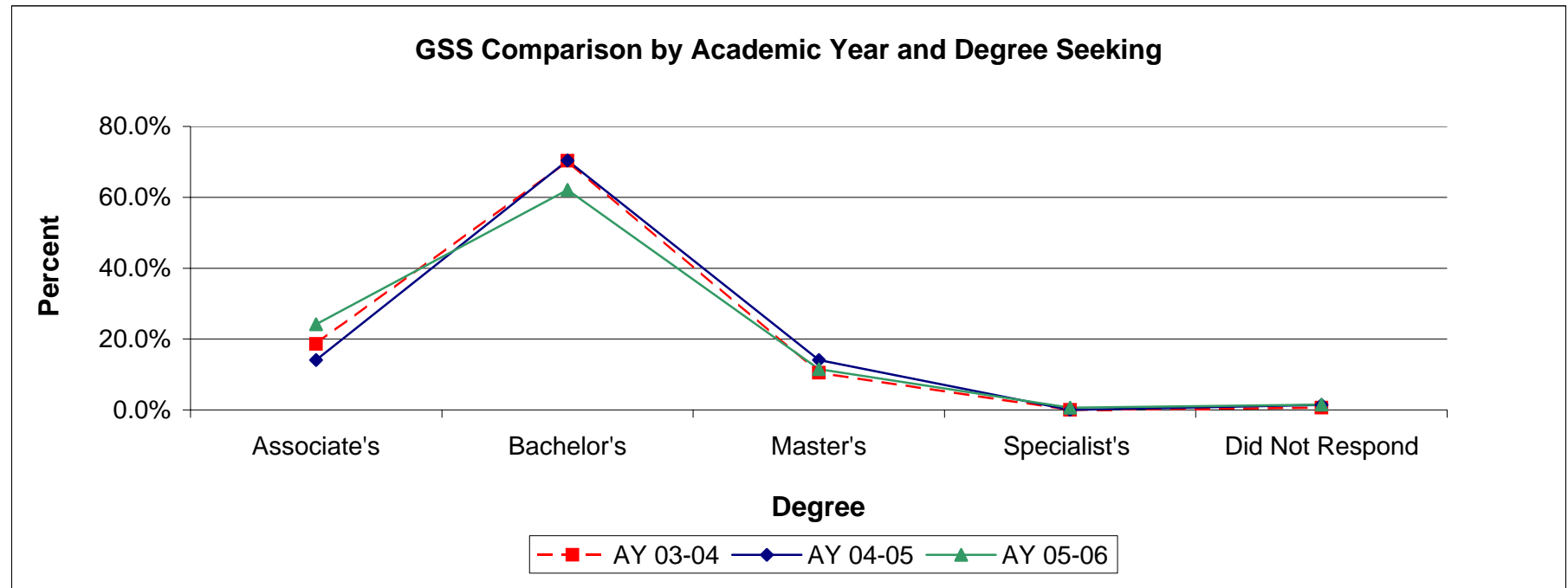


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Degree Seeking

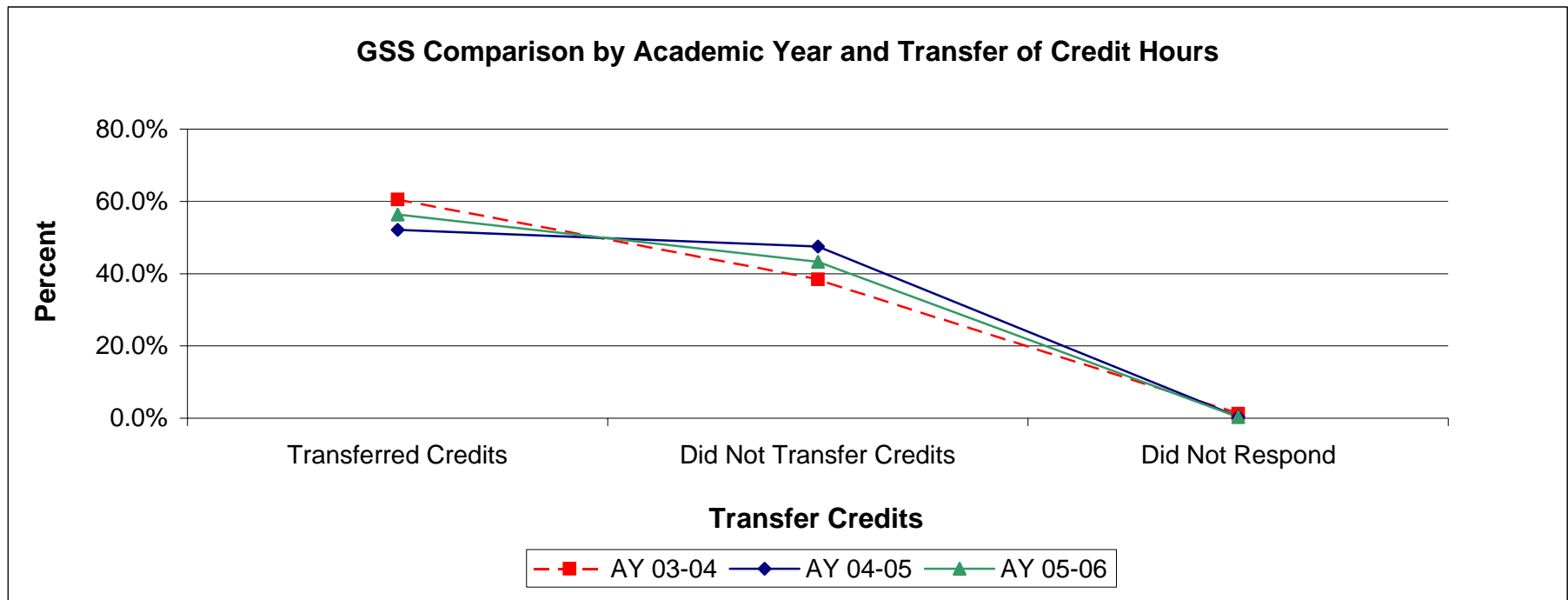


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Transfer of Credit Hours

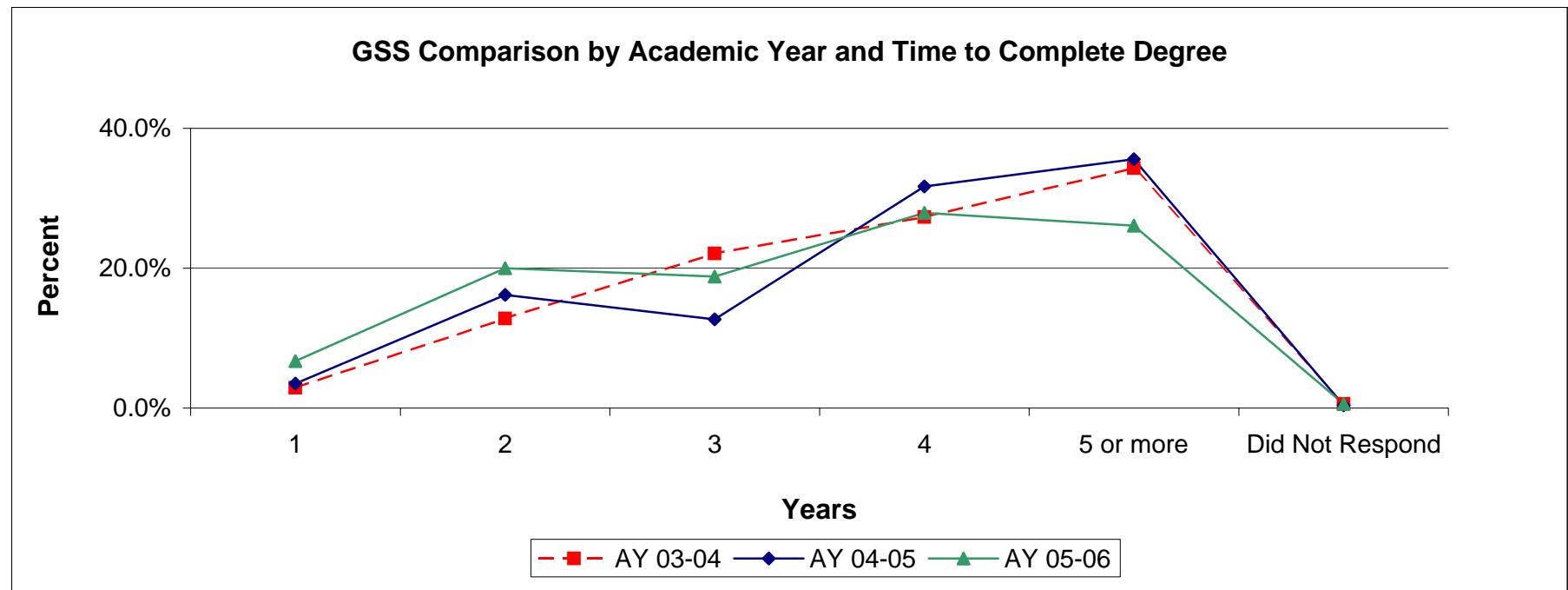


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Time to Complete Degree

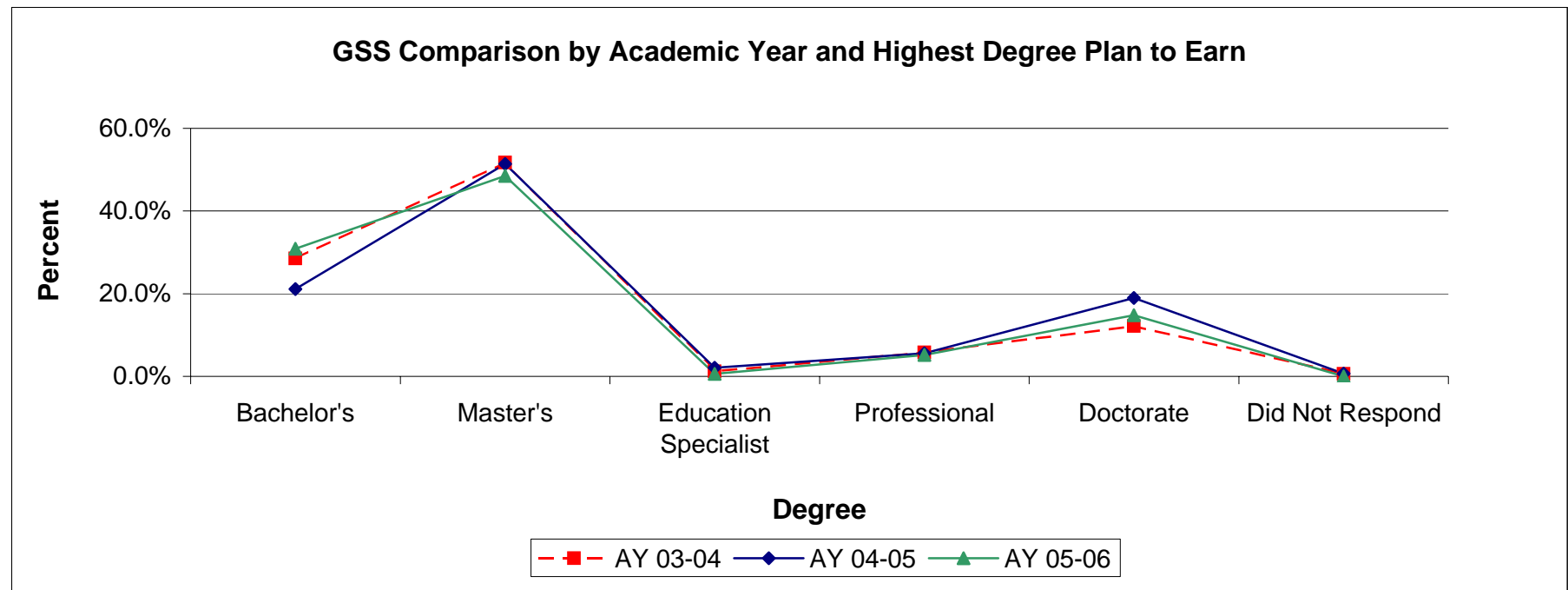


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Highest Degree Plan to Earn

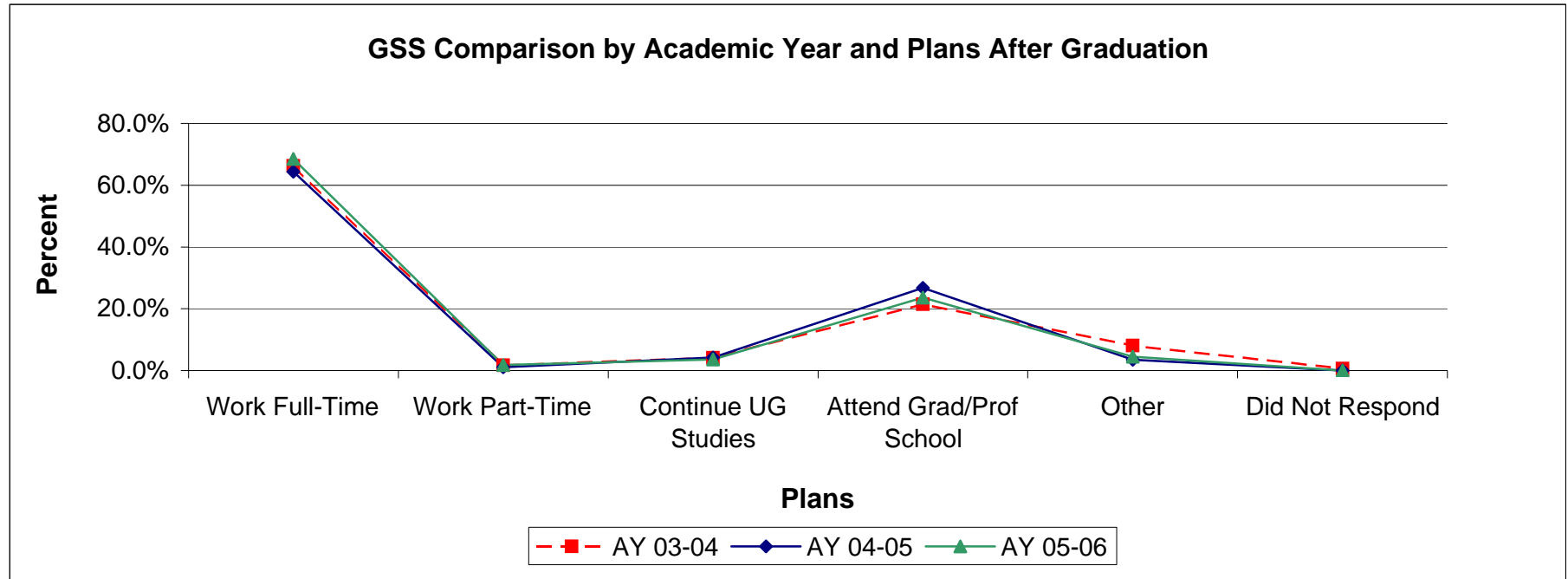


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Plans After Graduation

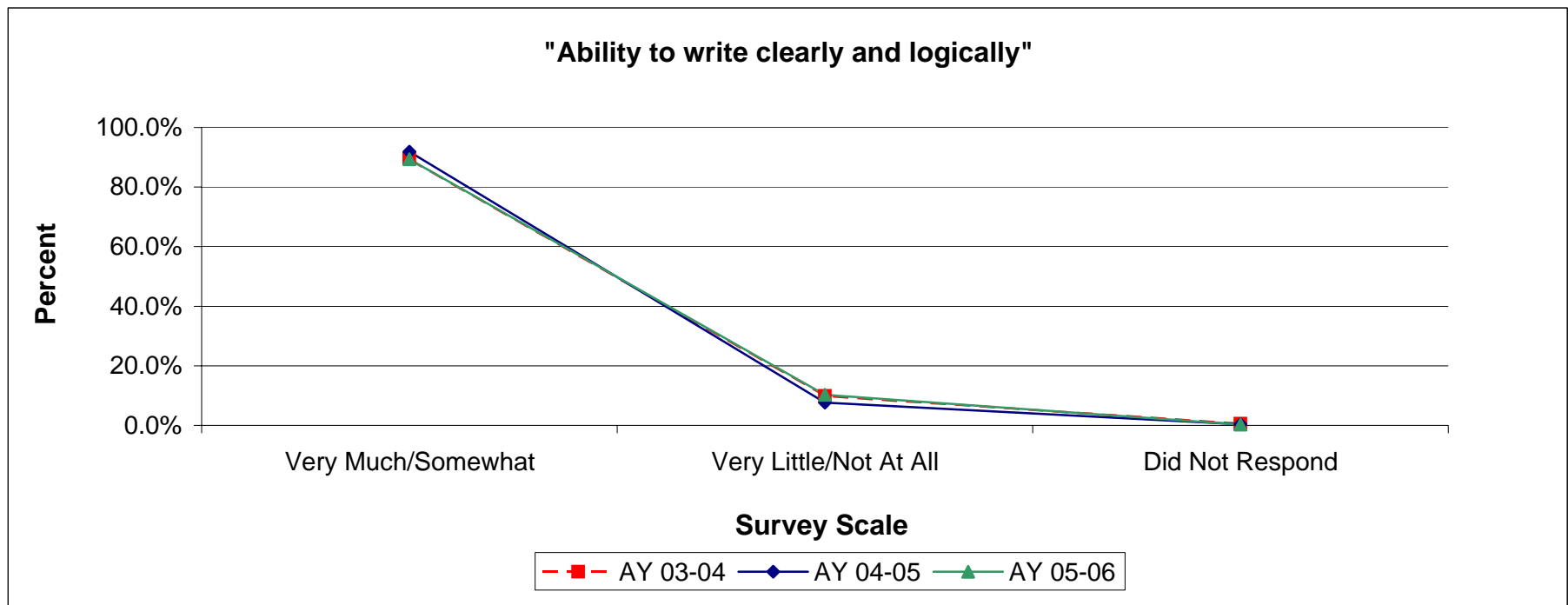

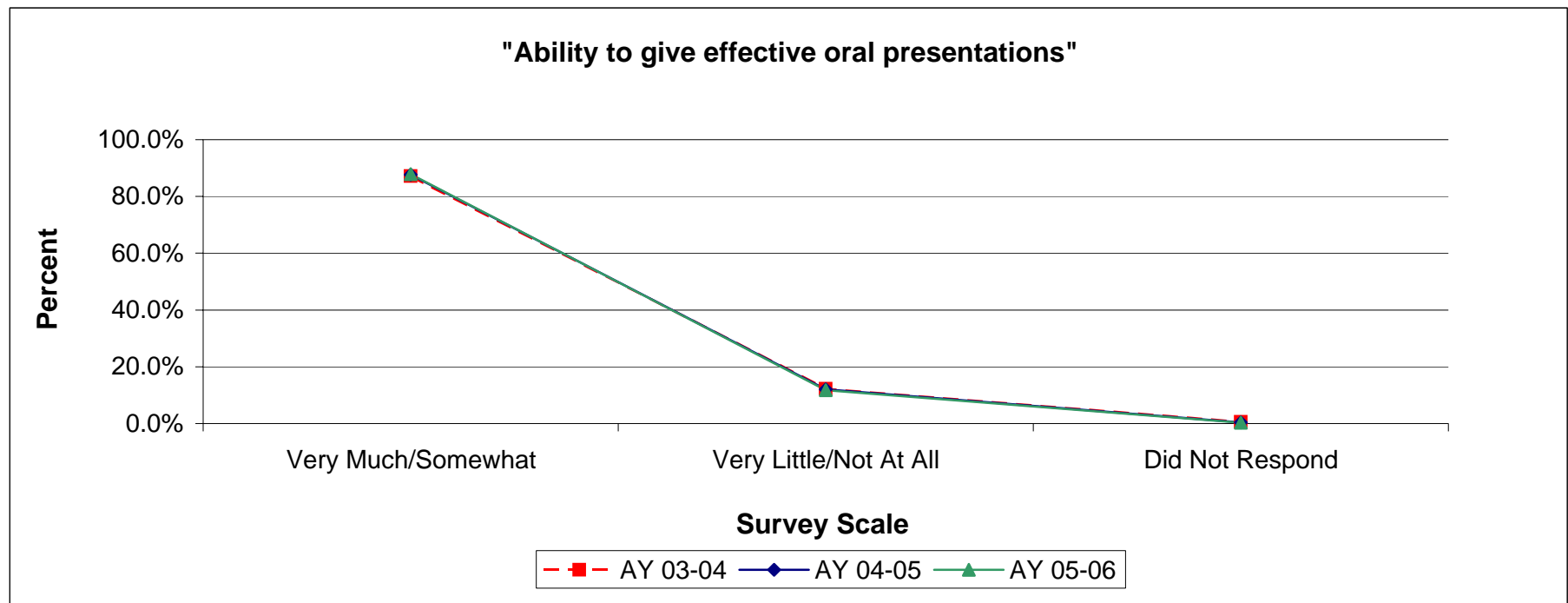

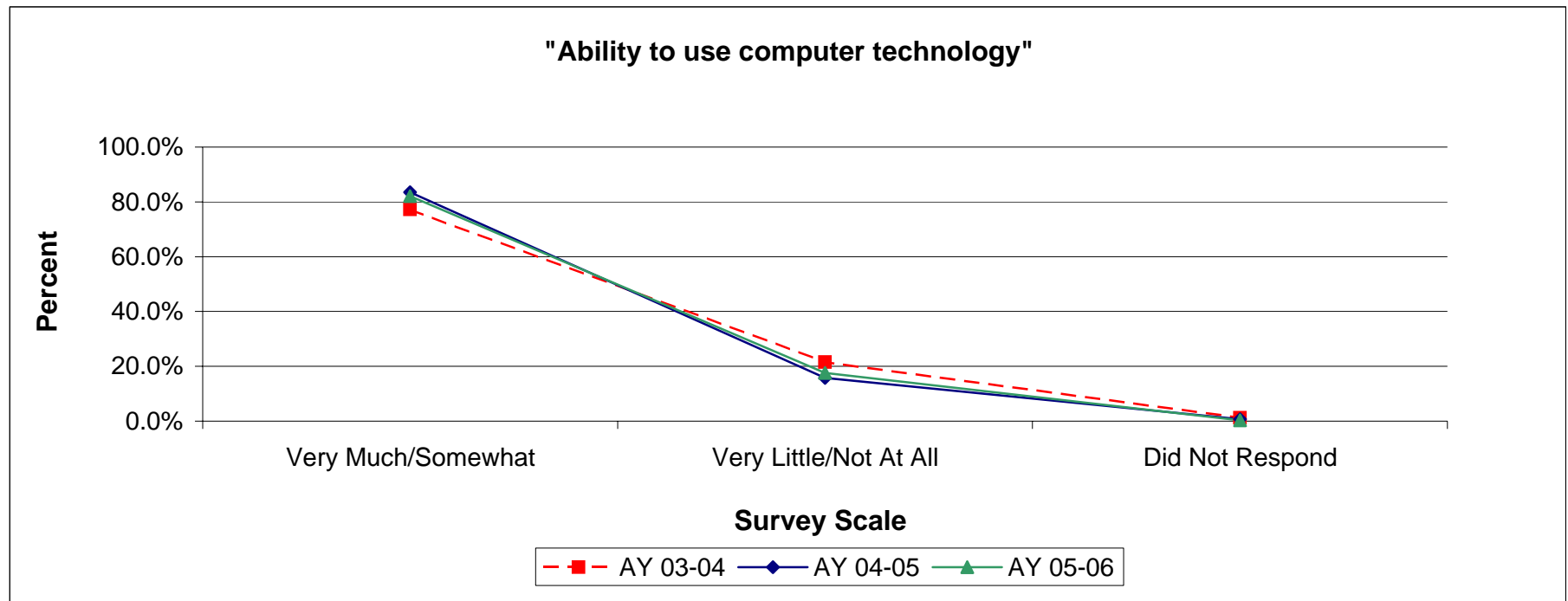


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #13 "Ability to use computer technology"

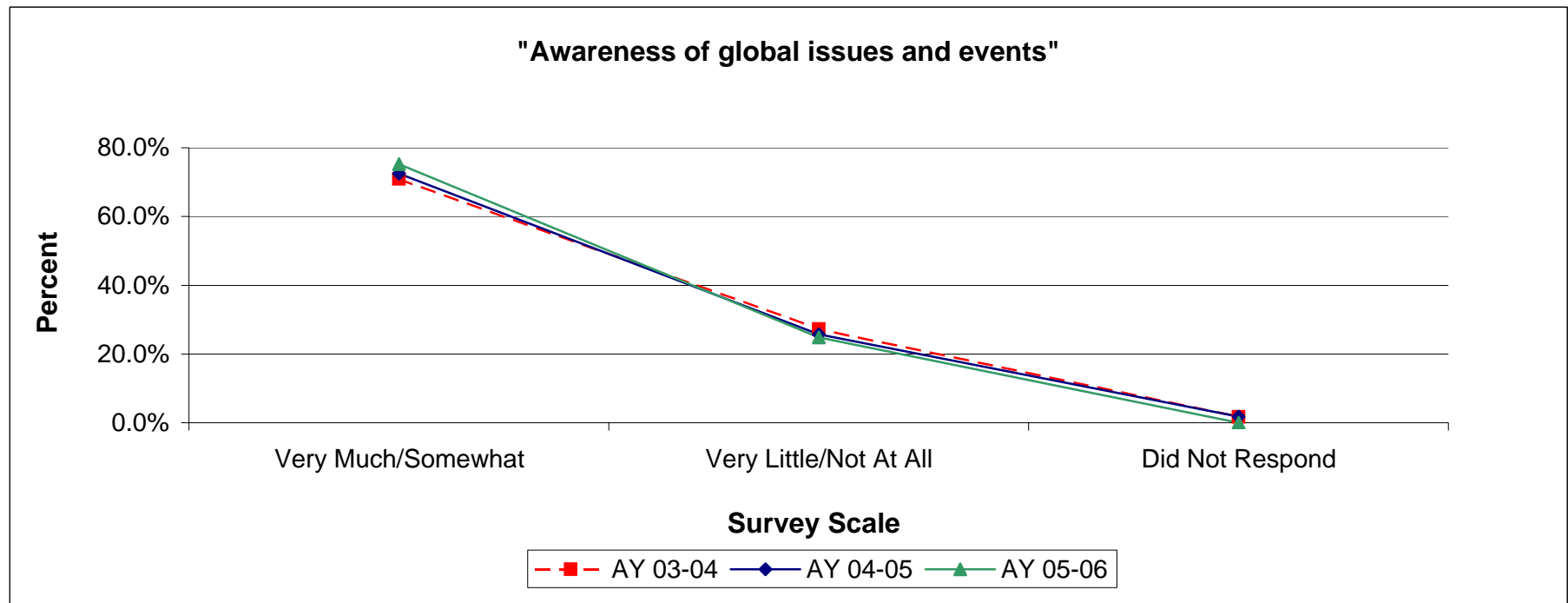


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #14 "Awareness of global issues and events"

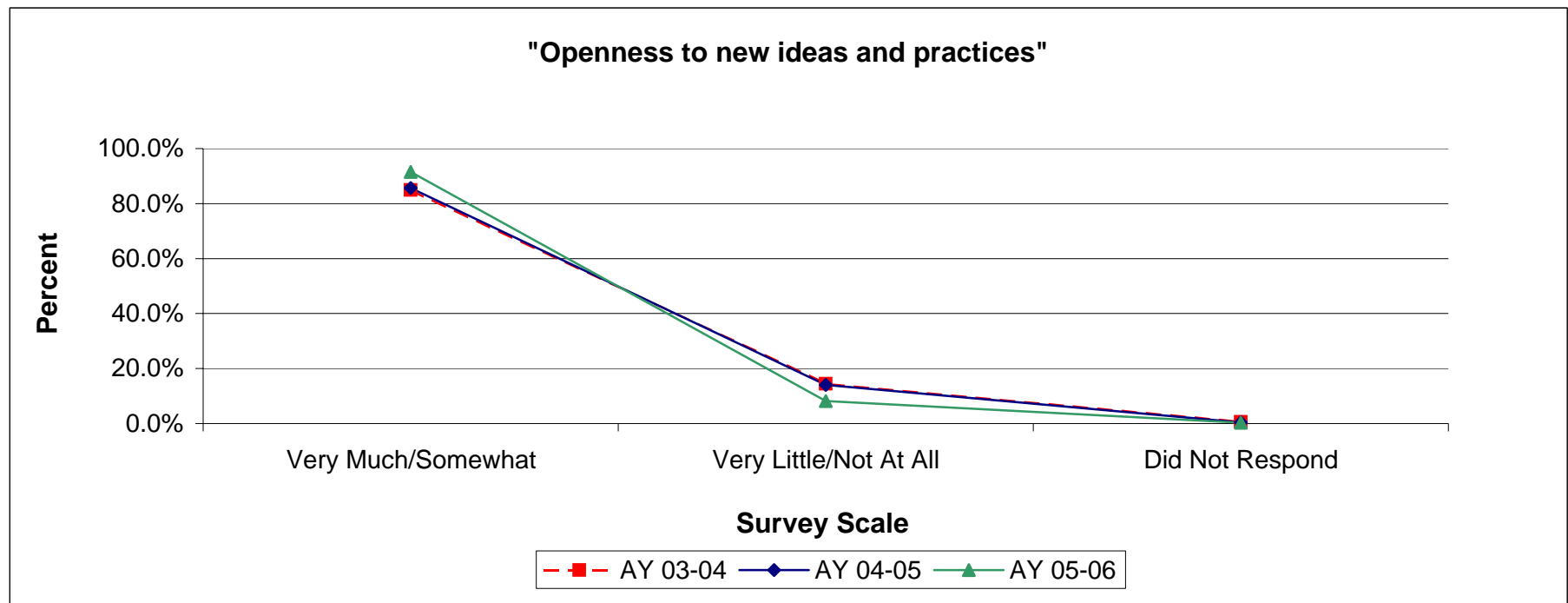

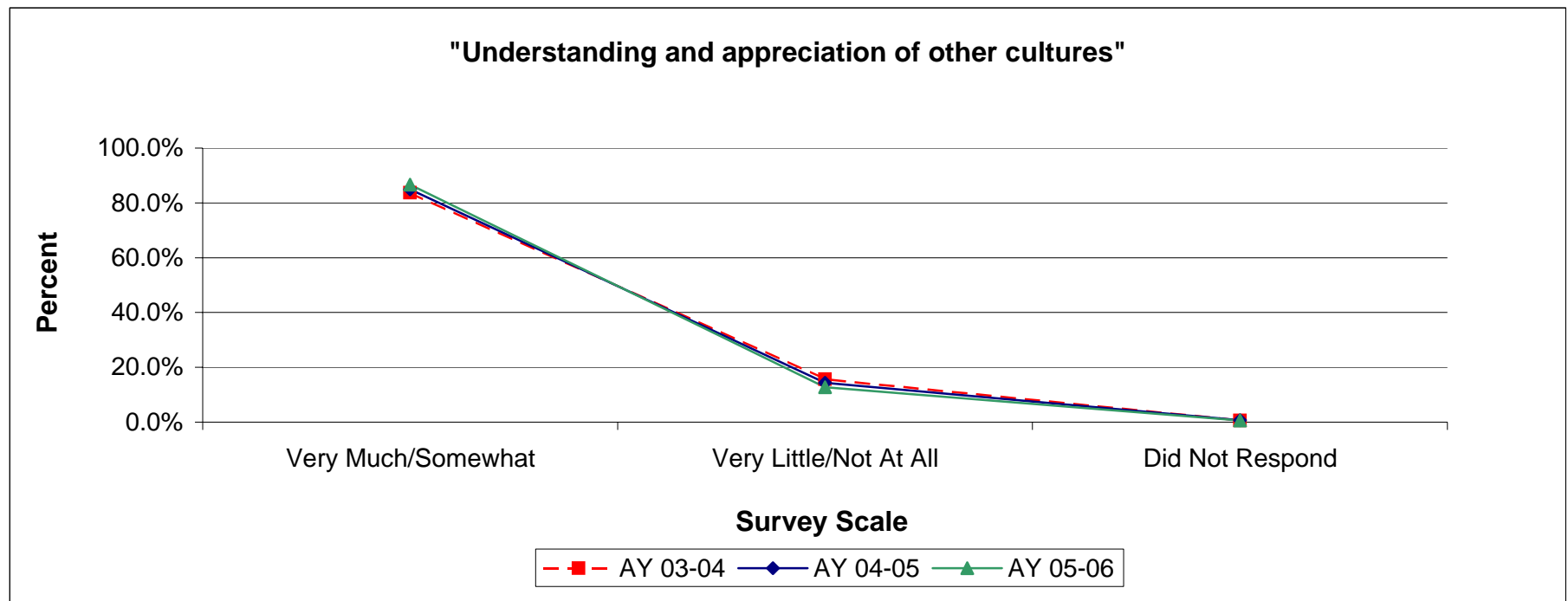

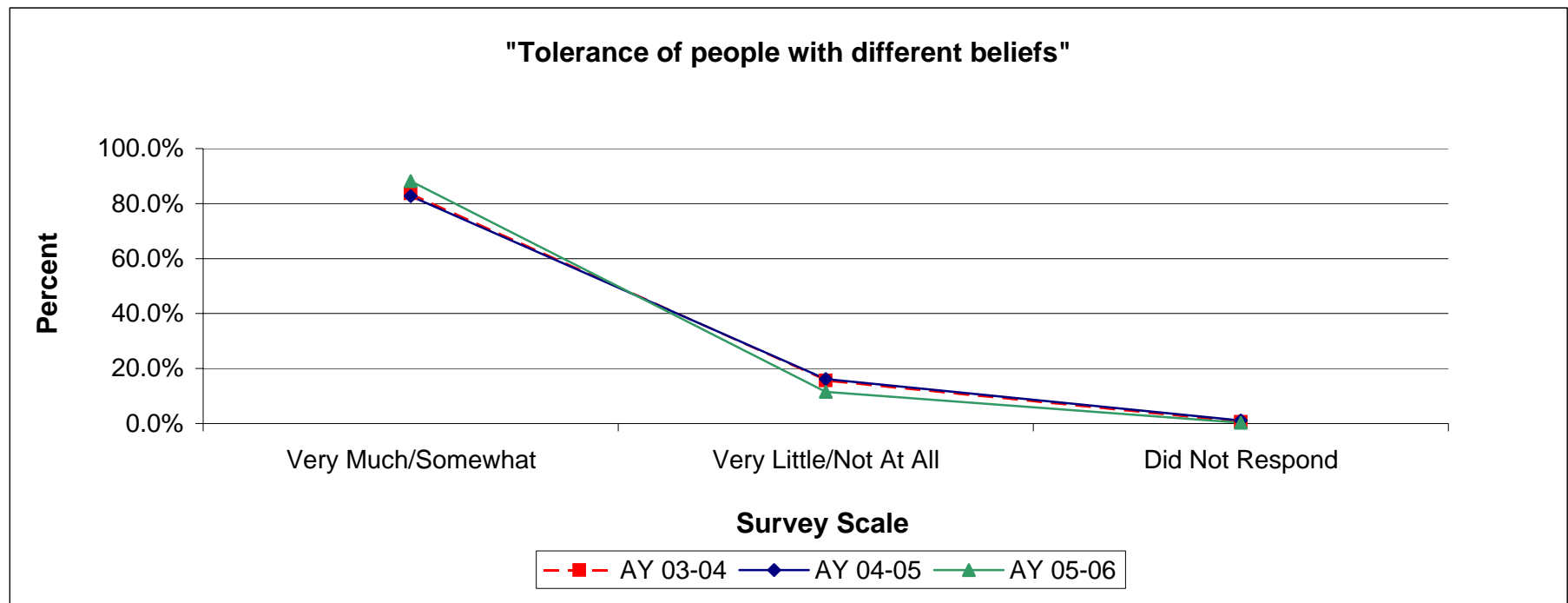

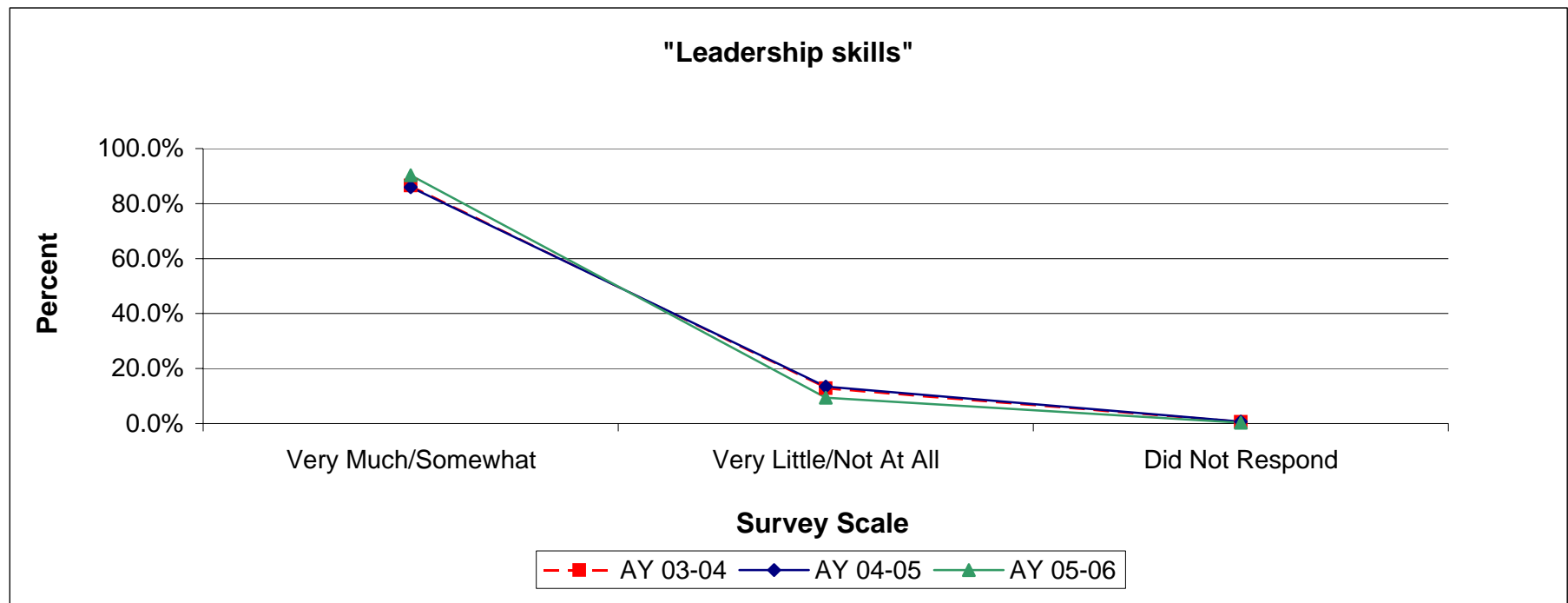


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #18 "Leadership skills"

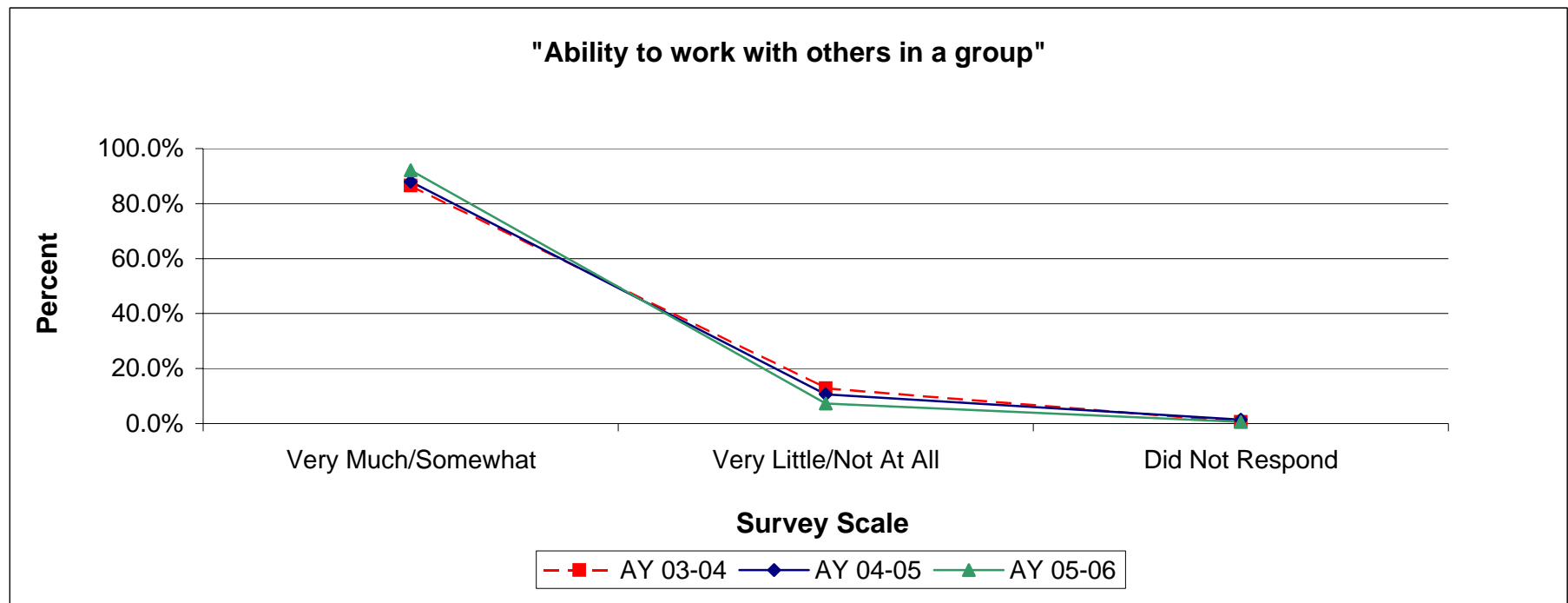


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #19 "Ability to work with others in a group"

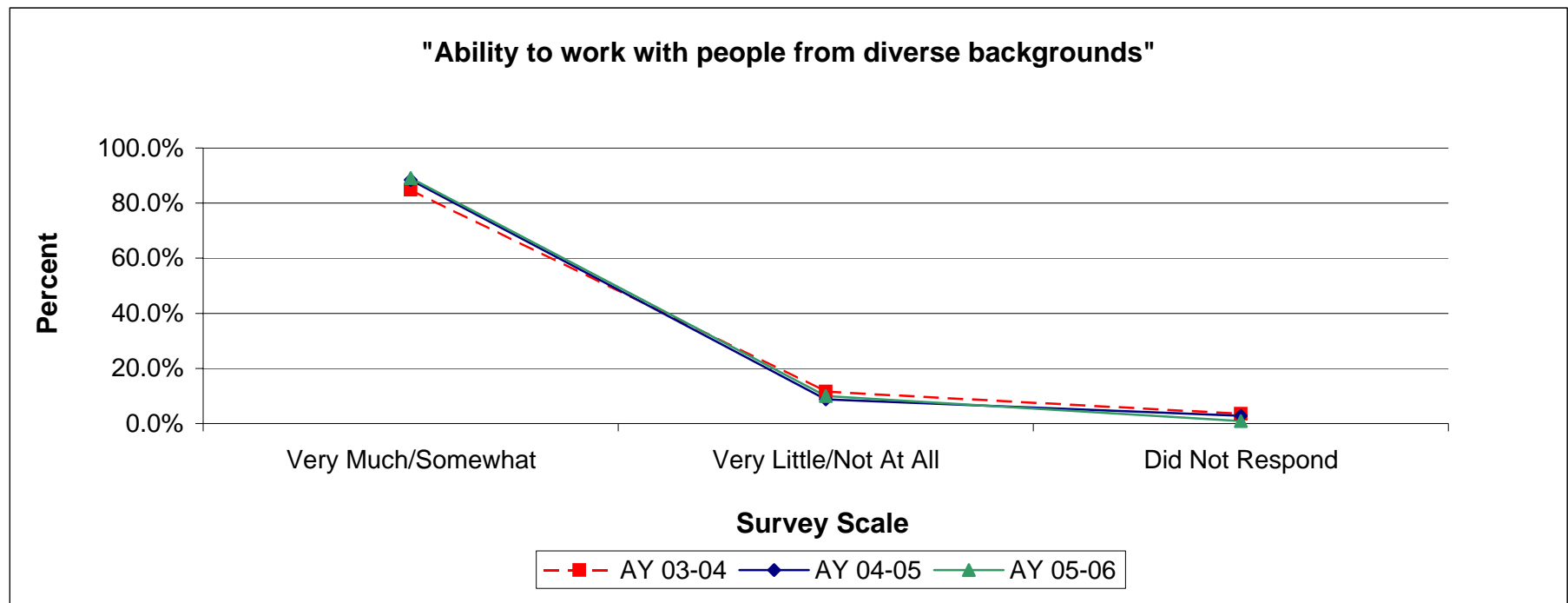

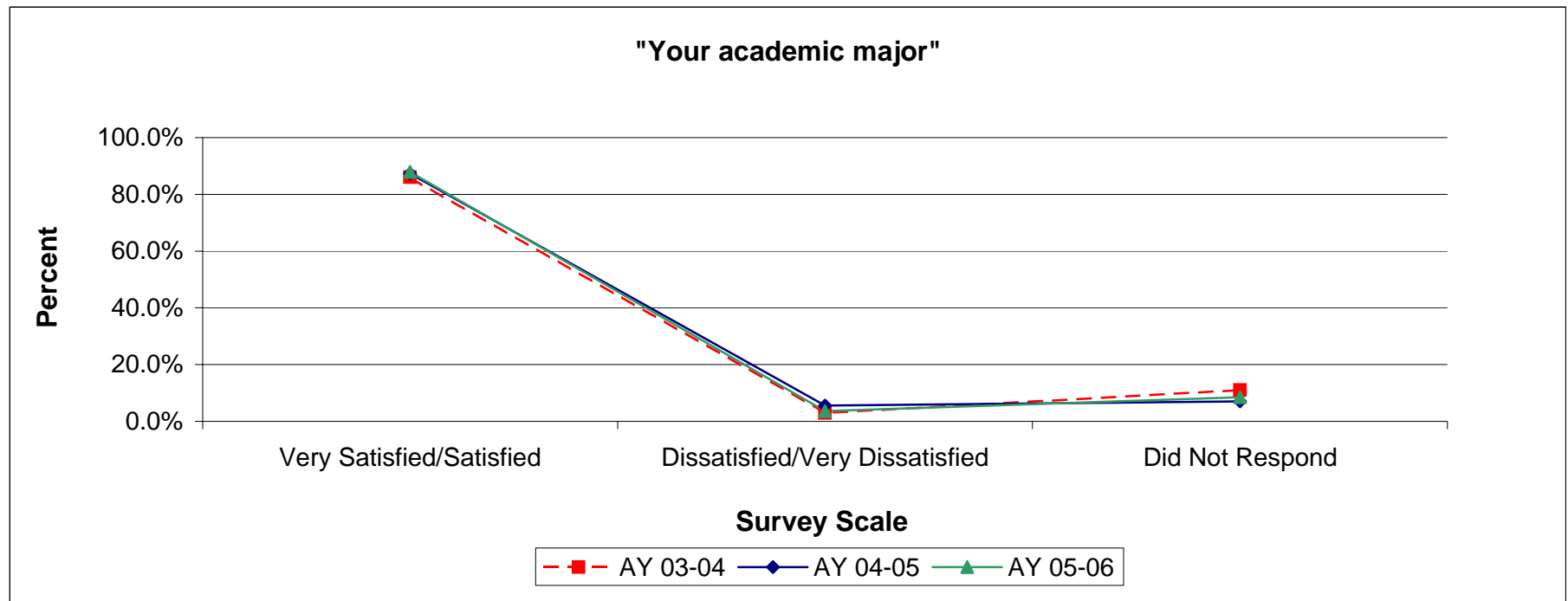


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #21 " Your academic major"

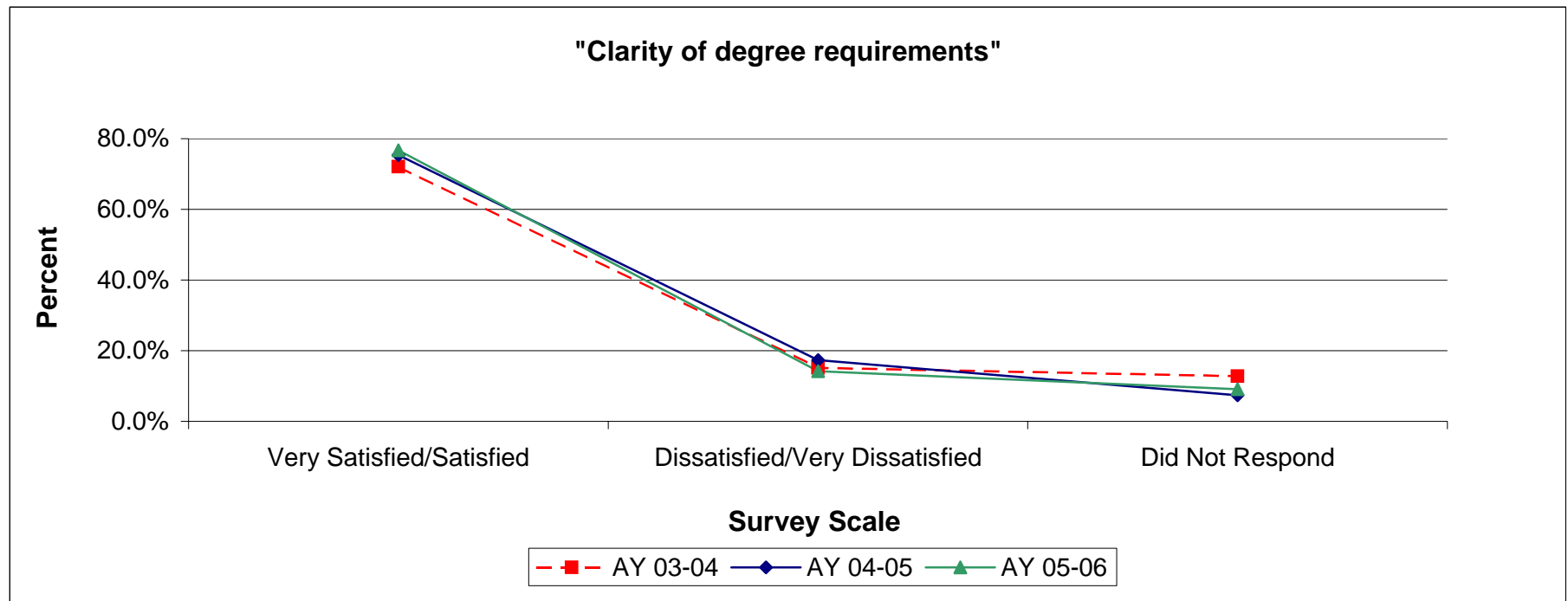


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #22 "Clarity of degree requirements"

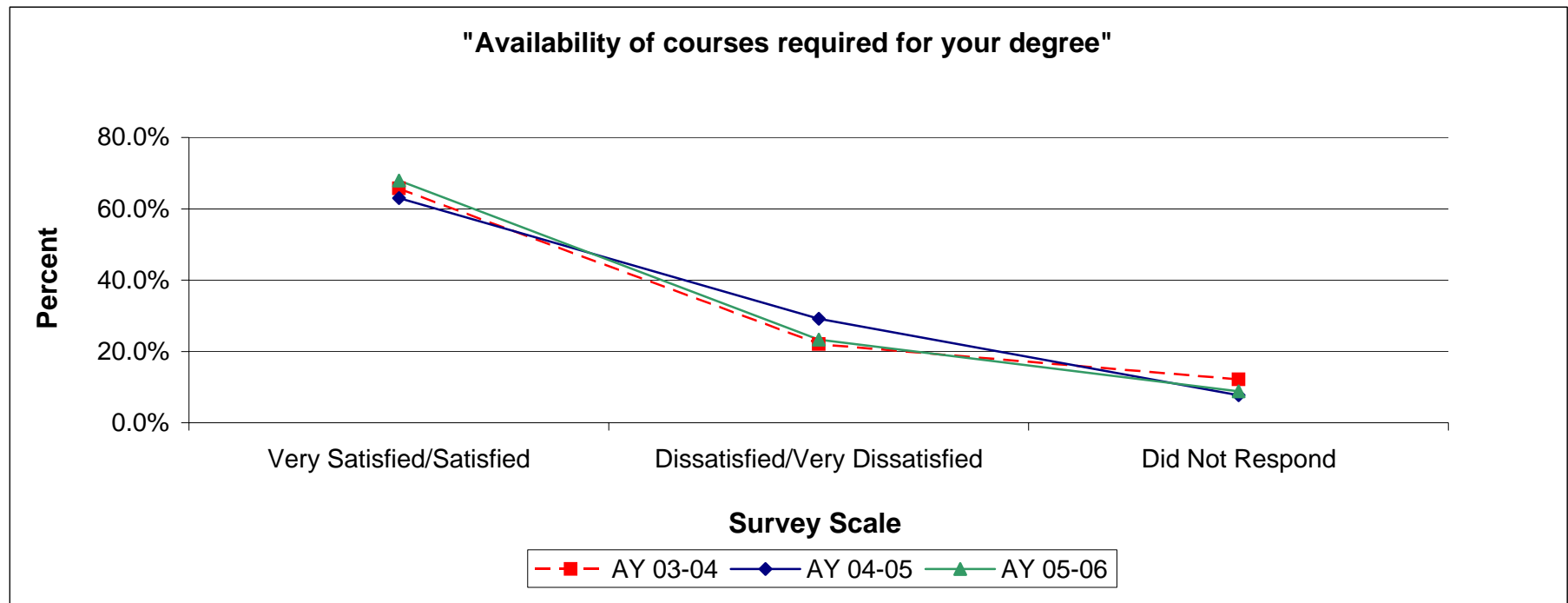


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #23 "Availability of courses required for your degree"

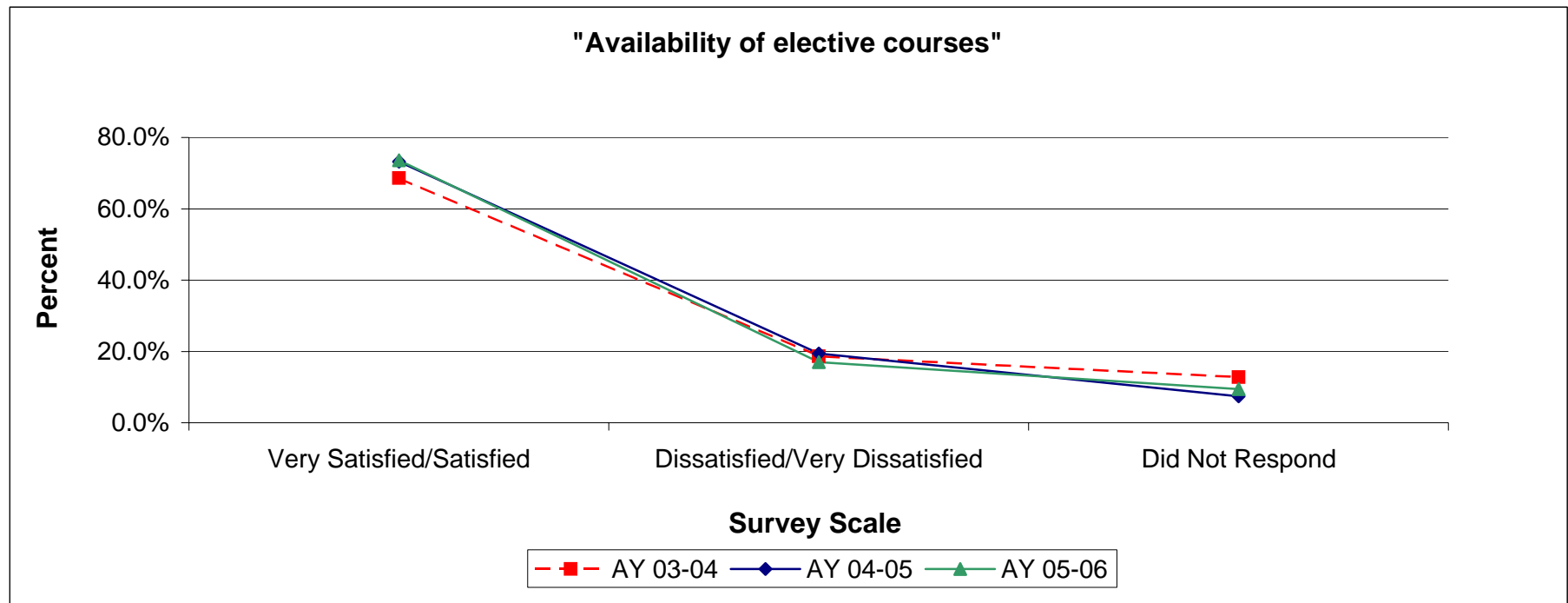


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #24 "Availability of elective courses"

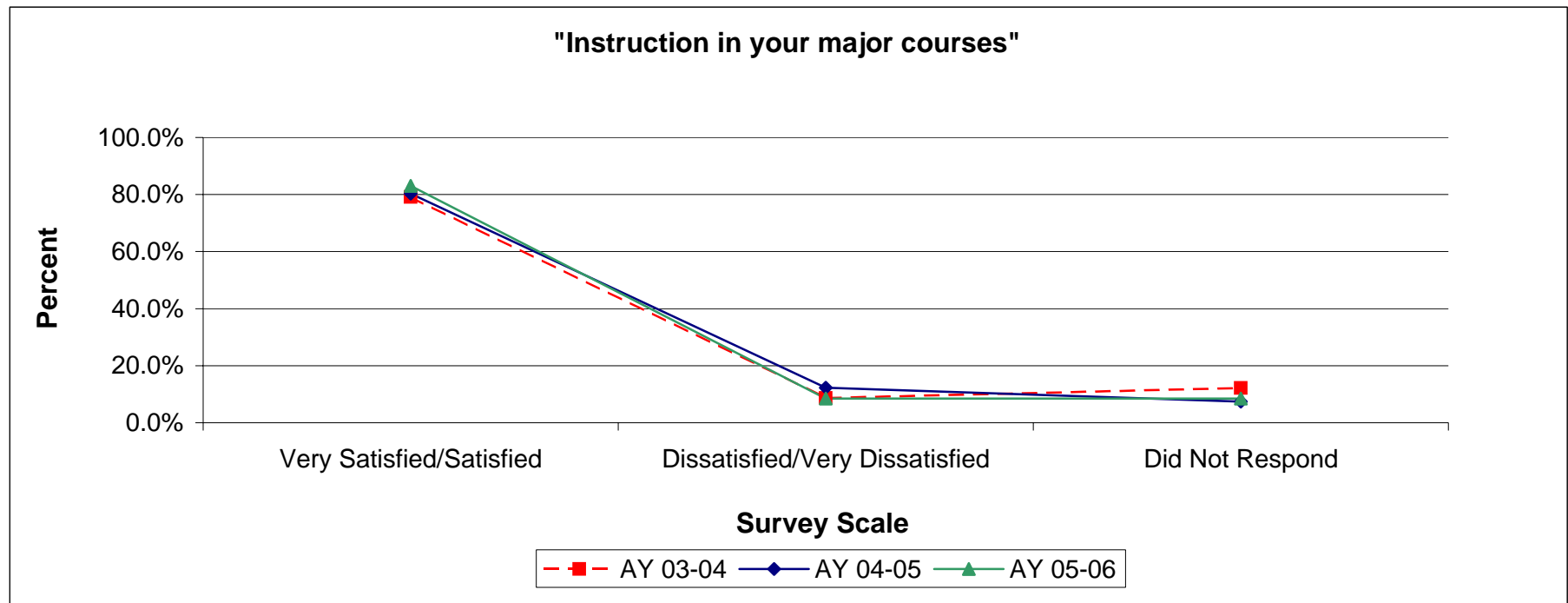


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #25 "Instruction in your major courses"

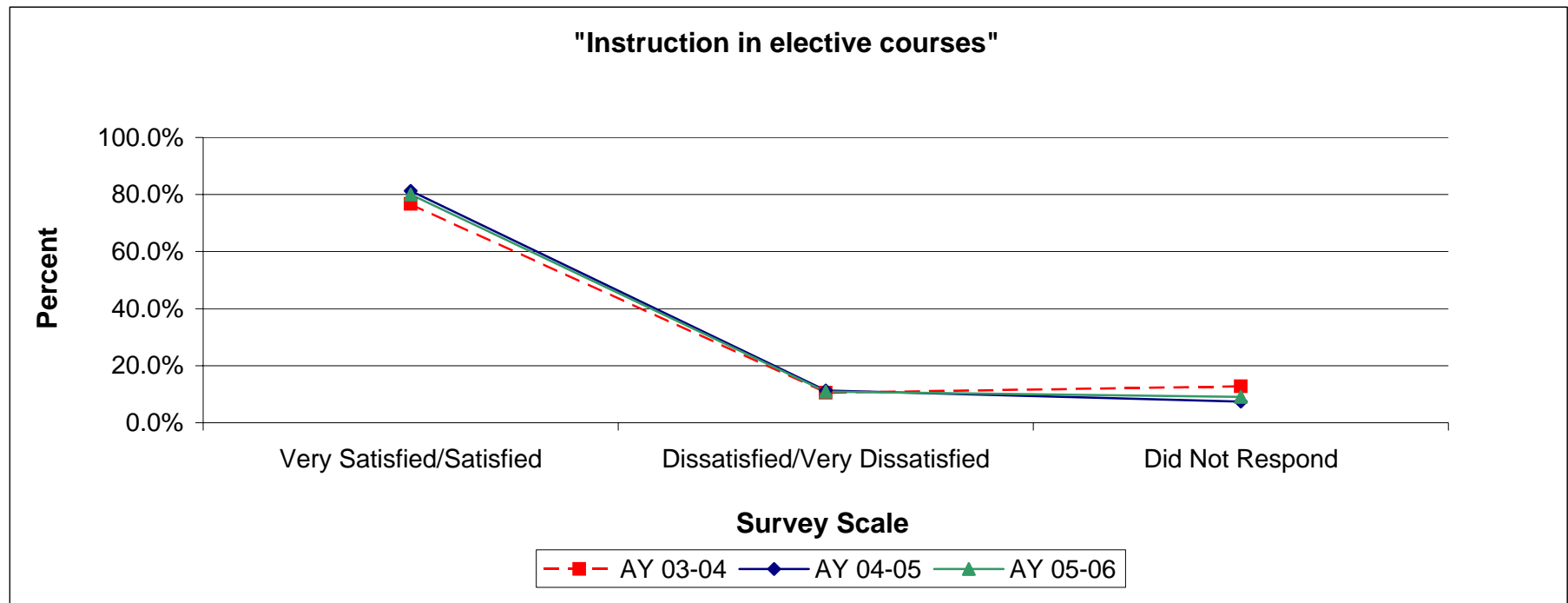


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #26 "Instruction in elective courses"

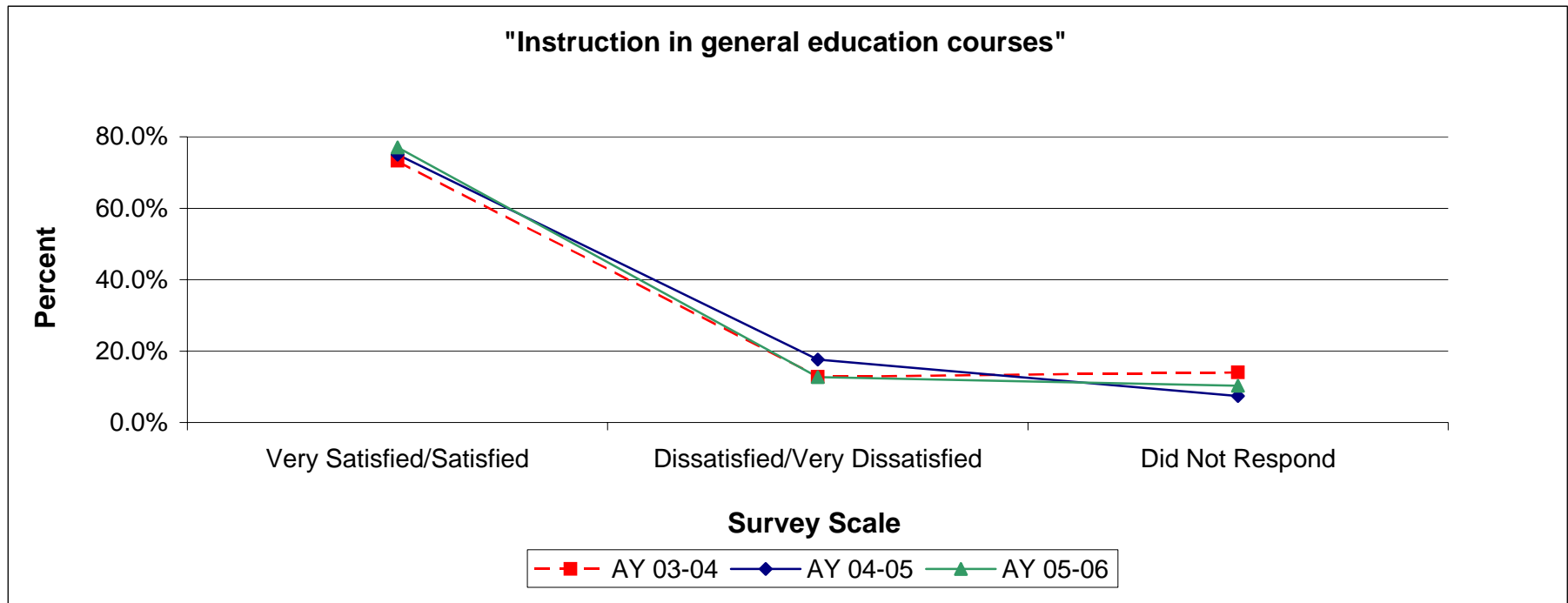


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #27 "Instruction in general education courses"

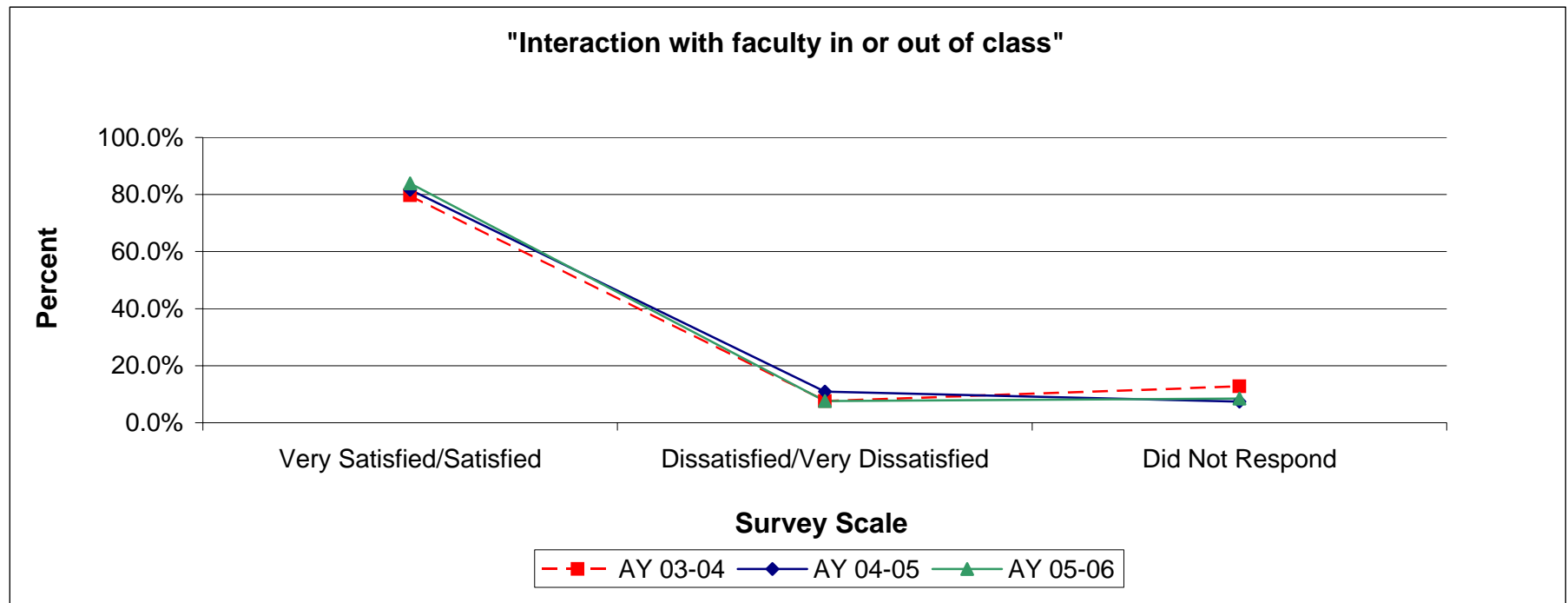

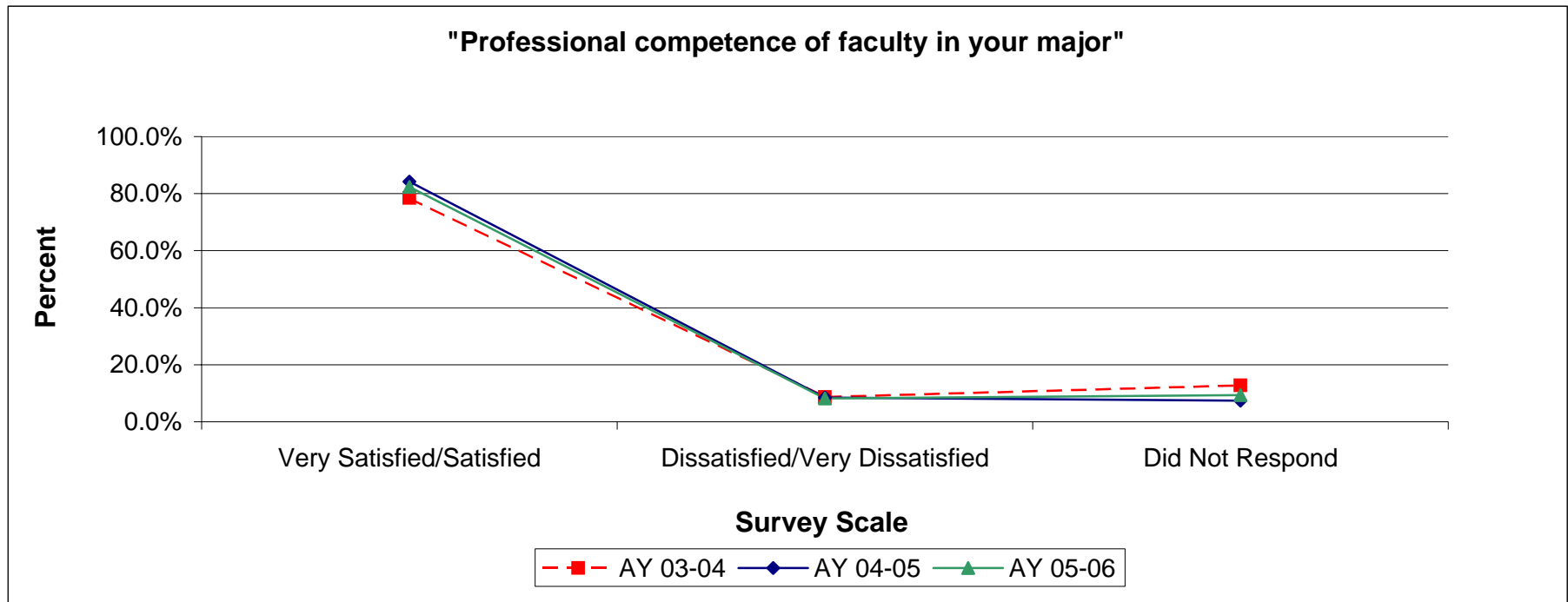


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #29 "Professional competence of faculty in your major"

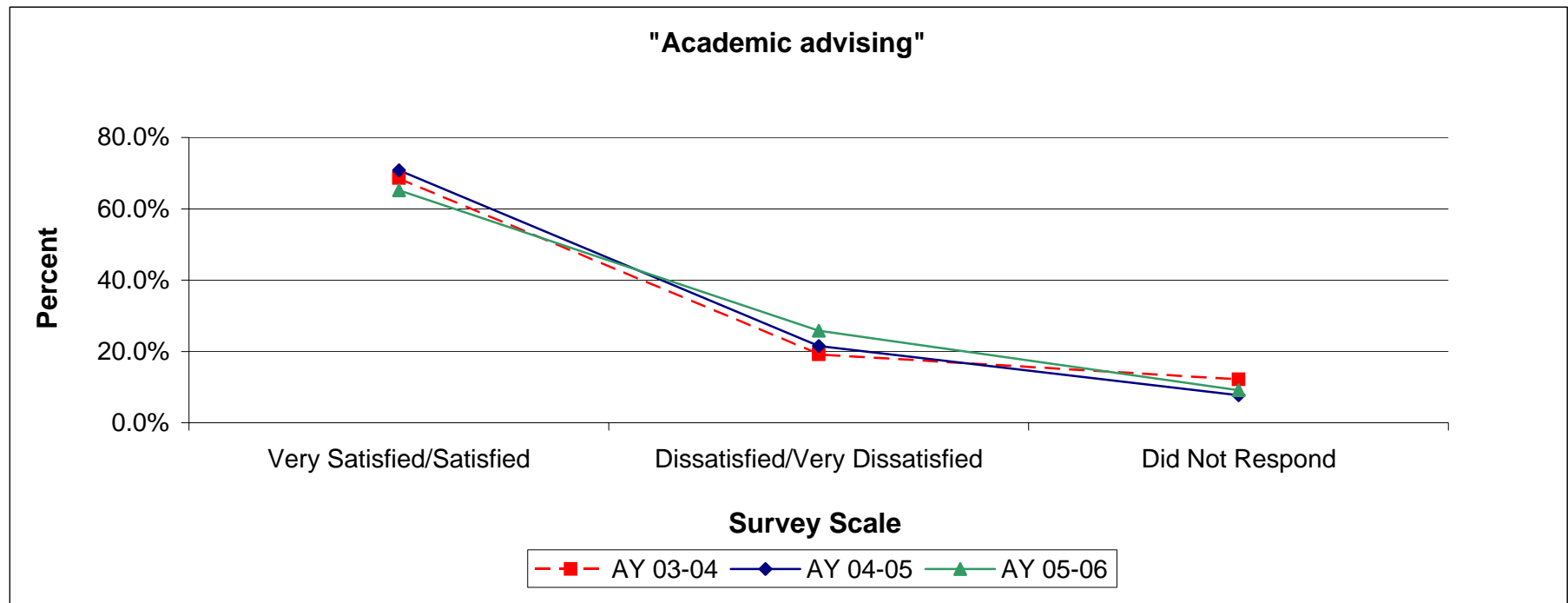

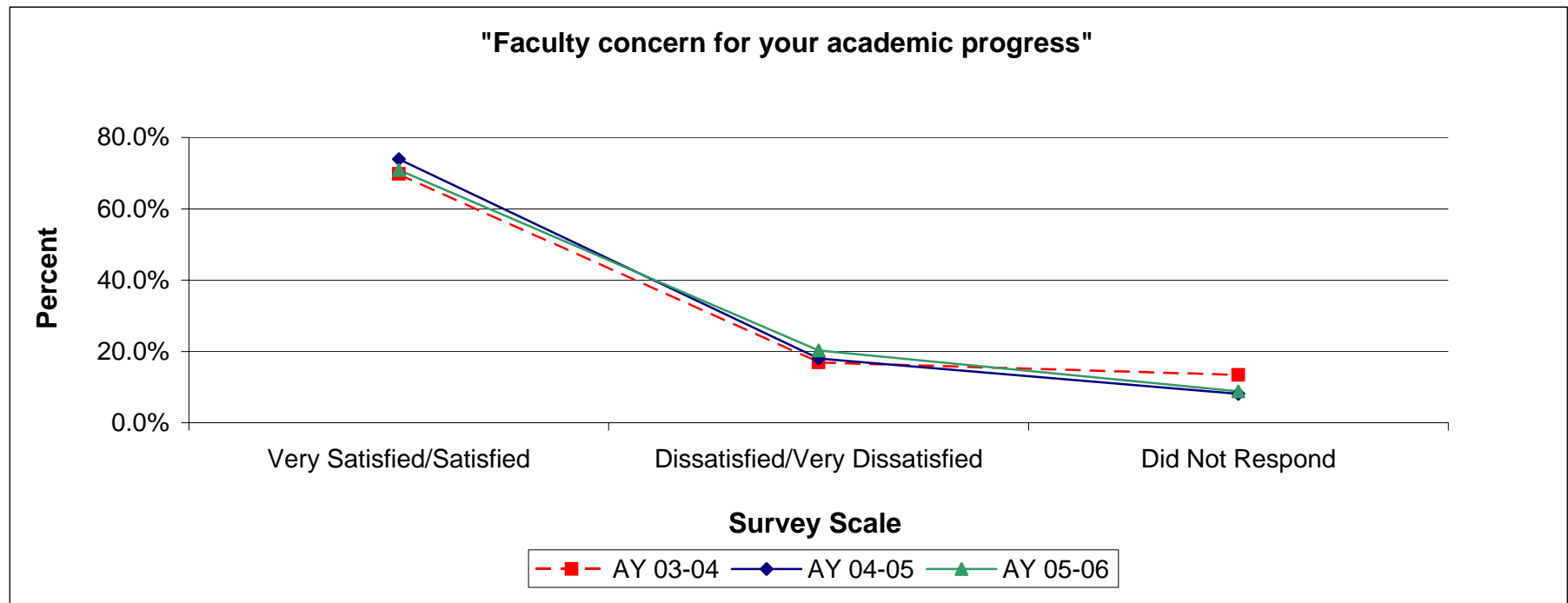


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #31 "Faculty concern for your academic progress"

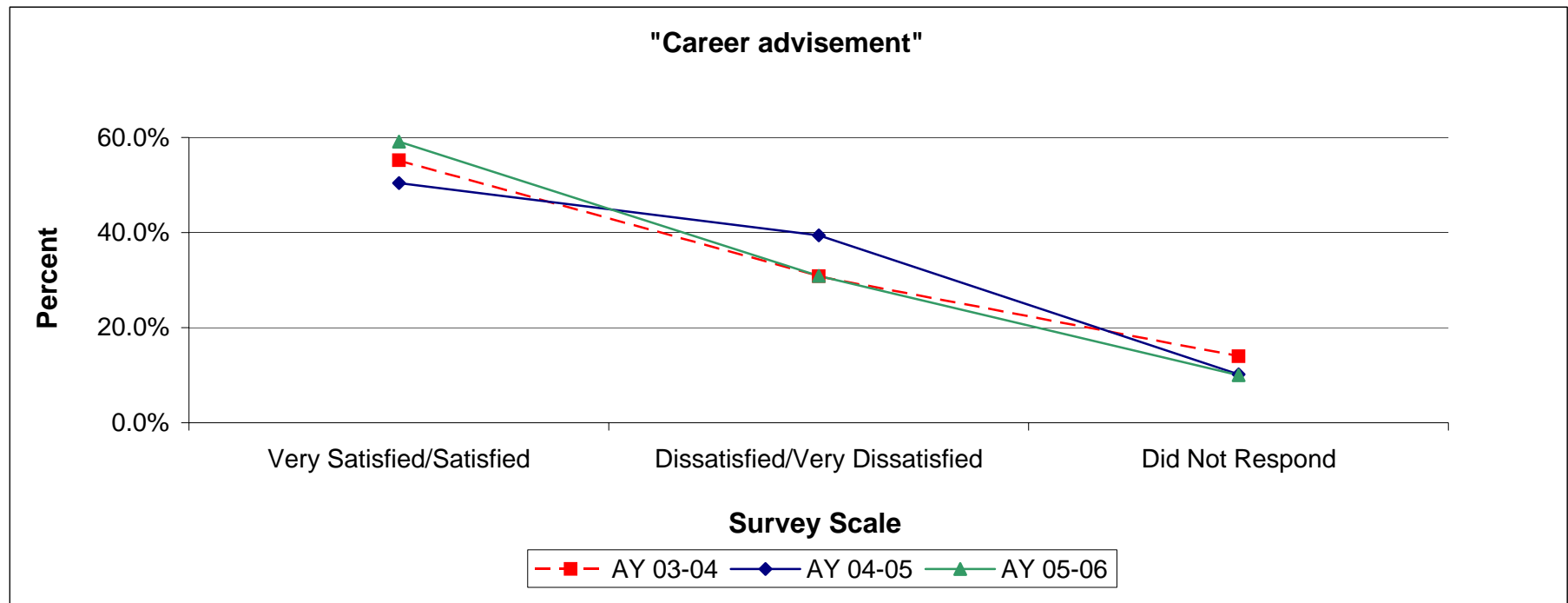

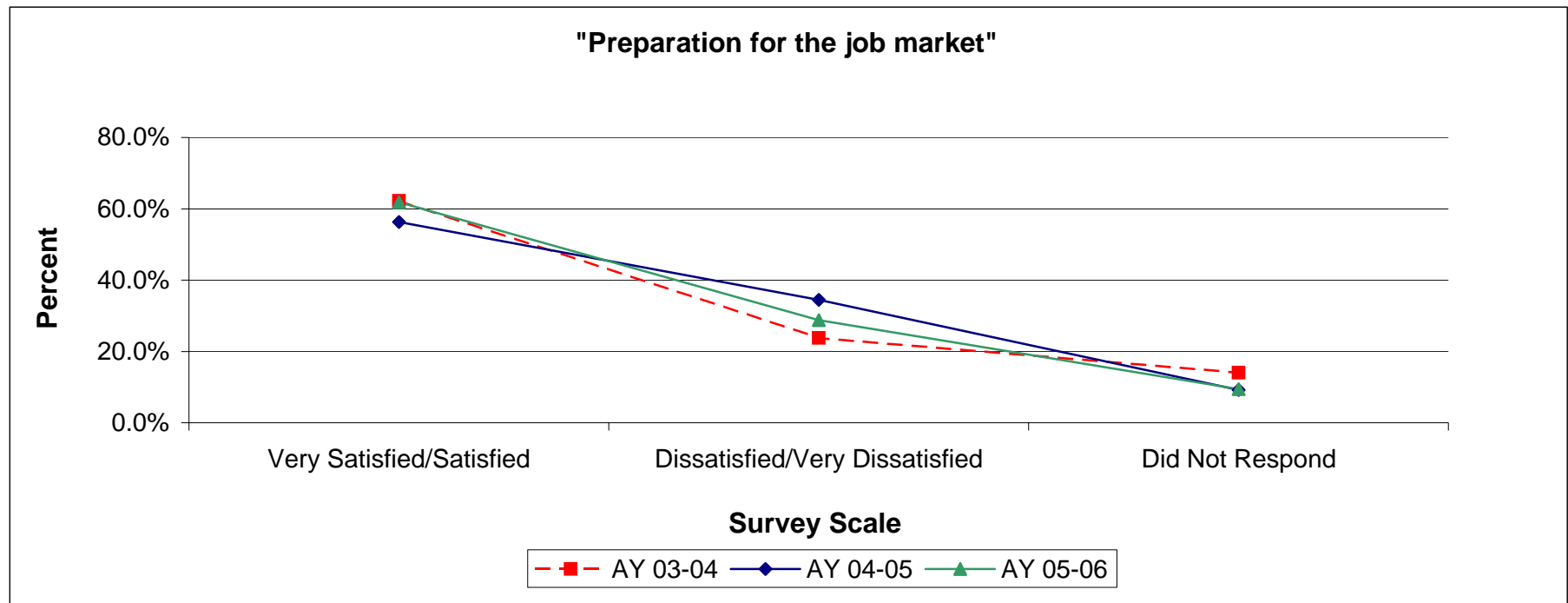

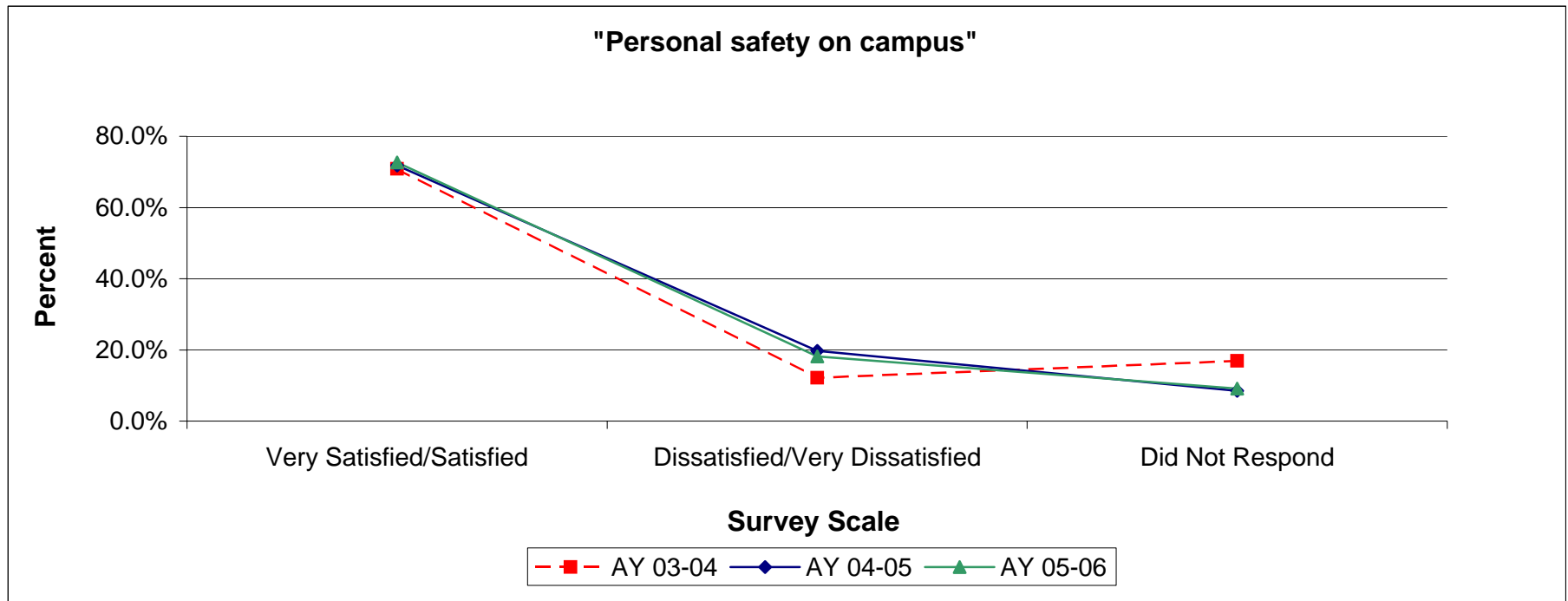

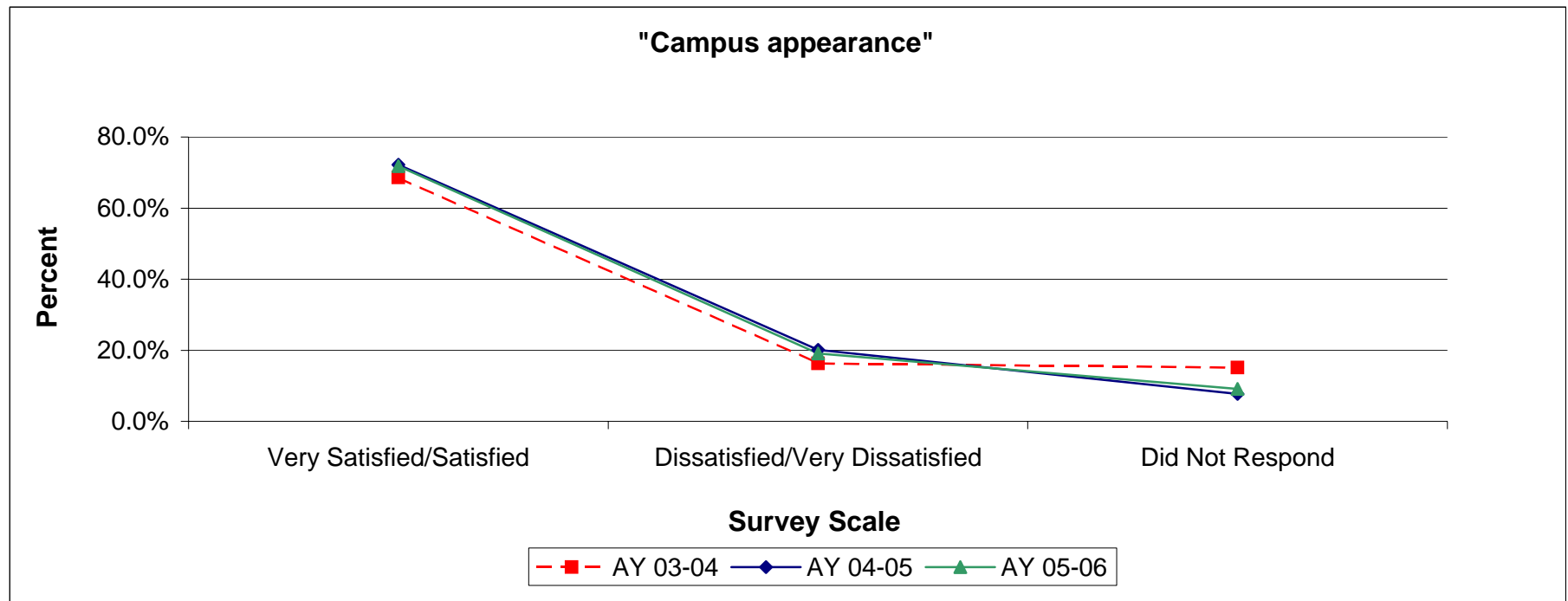

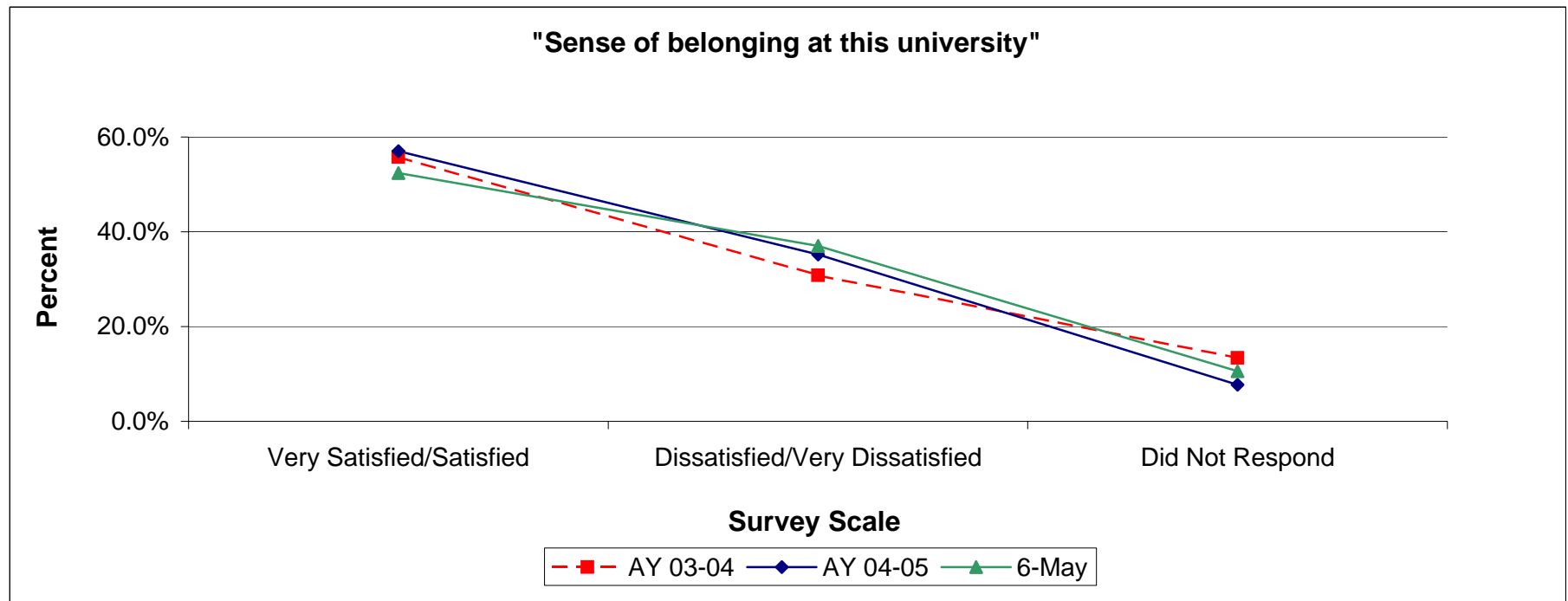


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #36 "Sense of belonging at this university"

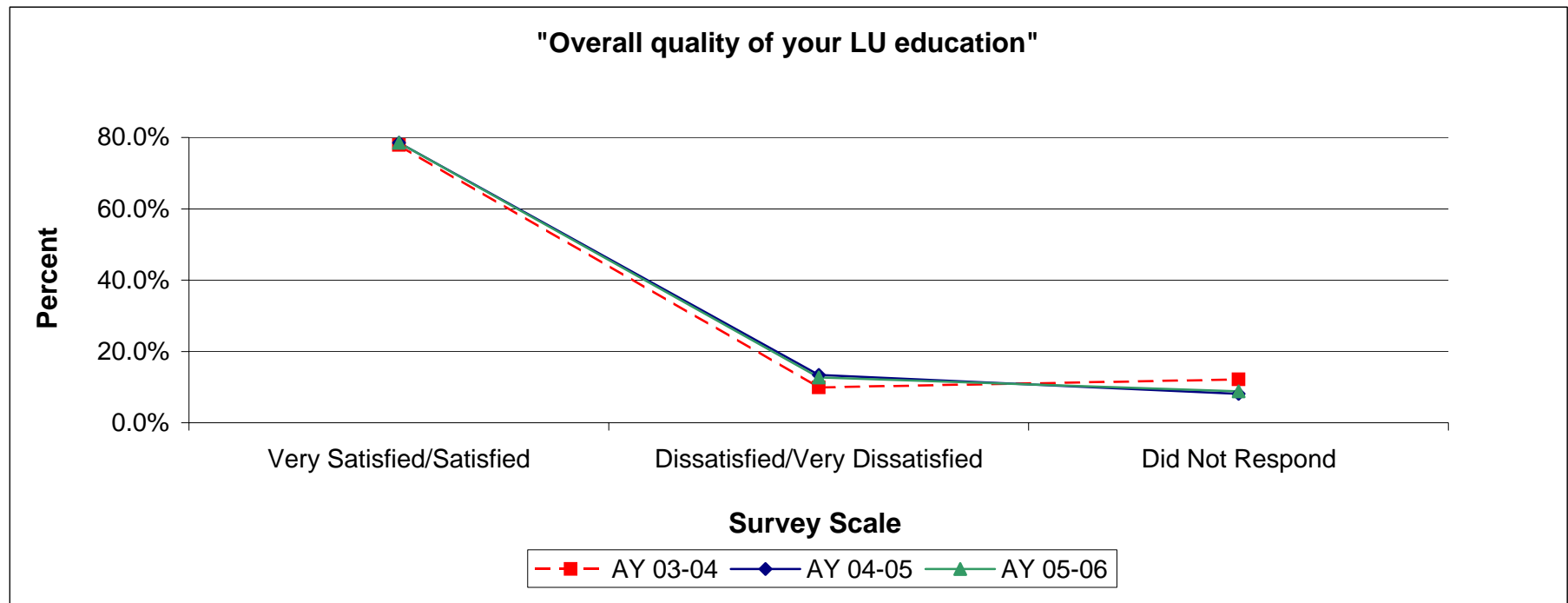


Lincoln University Graduating Student Survey Comparison by Academic Year and Response to Question #37 "Overall quality of your LU education"
