1992 (07/23/92)	Higher Education Amendments of 1992; Section 486 (c) of Public Law: 102-325 (S. 1150)"	Broadened sexual assault reporting and added required sexual assault policy statements. Specified effective dates of initial collection and dissemination requirements.
1998 (10/07/1998)	Higher Education Amendments of 1998; Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act, <u>Section 486 (e) of Public</u> <u>Law: 105-244</u> (H.R. 6)	Expanded crime categories that must be reported, added geographical breakdown, expanded definition of campus, expanded reporting of hate-crimes, added public crime log, and named law after Jeanne Clery.
2000 (10/28/2000)	<u>Victims of Trafficking and Violence</u> <u>Protection Act of 2000</u> ; Campus Sex Crimes Prevention Act; Section 1601 of <u>Public Law: 106-386</u> (H.R. 3244)	Added notice of where public sex offender registration information about offenders on campus may be obtained.
2008 (08/14/2008)	Higher Education Opportunity Act; Public Law: 110-315	Required statement of emergency response and evacuation procedures in annual security report and emergency notifications on campus (Timely Warnings). Included test of emergency procedures. Expanded hate crime statistics reported and statement of policy on law enforcement authority of campus personnel, established safeguards for "whistleblowers." Also included new policy on missing students and fire safety requirements.
2013 (03/07/2013)	Violence Against Women Reauthorization Act (VAWA) of 2013; Campus sexual violence, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking education and prevention; <i>Public Law: 113-4</i>	Crime reports would be expanded to include domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking. Includes updated requirements for sexual assault polices and replaces the "Sexual Assault Bill of Rights" with the "Victims' Rights" information. Universities must provide programs and training for new faculty, staff and students on sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking (SA, DV, DV, & ST) and implement ongoing training and programs for existing employees and students. Schools must create policies for the handling of DV, DV, & ST incidents and University officials responsible for handling disciplinary proceedings would be required to receive specific annual trainings on topics that pertain to SA, DV, DV, & ST.
