

Articulation Agreements

In response to a meeting with Records Office and recently requested information about articulation agreements, I am writing about our FLW nursing program. Since the inception of the program in 1989, Microbiology, a requirement for the nursing program, has been taught at Truman Education Center by Drury University specifically for our nursing students. It is my understanding that a sufficient microbiology lab was not available to support Lincoln offering this course, thus Drury became responsible for this.

Thus, since 1989 Microbiology from Drury University has been and is currently the microbiology course in Lincoln's FLW Nursing Program. Based on this, I am requesting that:

- BIO 208 Microbiology from Drury University be a standard equate to BIO 301/301L Microbiology at Lincoln University
- No transfer of credit form will need to be completed for FLW nursing students who take BIO 208 Microbiology from Drury University
