AGRICULTURE, AGRIBUSINESS and ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

(Contingent upon available funds)

PURPOSE: To attract qualified students to careers in agriculture. Under-represented

students majoring in agriculture are strongly encouraged to apply.

AMOUNT: \$4,000 may be applied to tuition/incidental and activity fees. Each

scholarship is awarded for one academic year. There are no automatic scholarship renewals. Each student must submit a new application each

year. Only complete applications will be considered.

ELIGIBILITY: A. U.S. Citizenship or U.S. Permanent Residency is required.

Additionally, applicants must meet one of the following criteria (B or C).

- B. An applicant must have graduated from an accredited high school (Missouri and out-of-state applicants are welcome), and
 - Ranked in the top 20% of his/her high school graduating class, or
 - Achieved an ACT composite score of 18 or higher, or
 - Earned a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
 - Student must be enrolled as an Agriculture major at Lincoln University to be eligible for the scholarship.
- C. A college level applicant must be a full-time student with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- D. High school seniors must include a brief essay expressing career goals.
- E. Scholarship renewal: A student who falls below the minimum 2.5 GPA requirement or changes their major from Agriculture to a non-Agriculture major will forfeit the scholarship.
