3. Fresh Start offering special programming for students who return after being suspended or on academic probation. Contact CYFE.

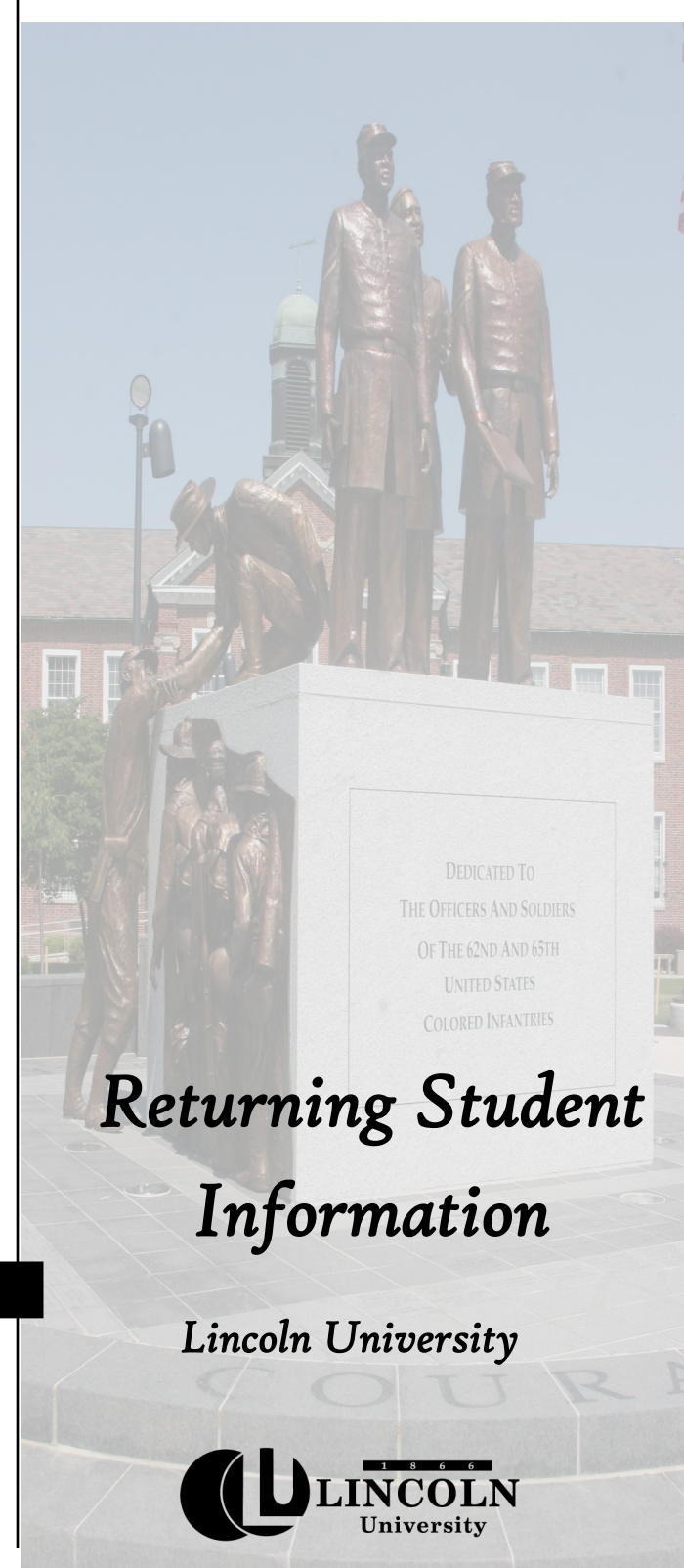
4. The Center for Academic Enrichment—offering professional tutoring services in the areas of writing and mathematics.

Determine your academic status and necessary requirements for continued probation.

Complete your FASFA no later than March 15 of each year.

Determine if you have been selected for verification. If so, complete the verification form and provide copies of your (and your parent's, if you are a dependent student) tax transcript to the Department of Student Financial Aid.

If you have been suspended, have less than a 2.0 cumulative GPA or have not been meeting satisfactory academic progress, you will need to file a Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) appeal. **This appeal is separate from an appeal filed through the Academic Routine Committee.**
