BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Lincoln University offers a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration through its College of Business. The 121 credit hour program is designed to provide students with a broad background in all phases of business including marketing, management, finance, economics and accounting. Students may choose an emphasis in the following areas: Accounting, Business Administration, Business Education, Economics, Marketing, Office Management and Public Administration.

Lincoln University will accept a maximum of 64 St. Louis Community College college level credit hours. Students seeking a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration are strongly encouraged to complete STLCC's General Transfer Studies associate degree curriculum before transferring.
