# <u>6. C. Outdoor Fitness & Basketball Courts (with Jefferson City Parks) (Enclosure 6):</u>

Discussion was held on the recommendation to proceed with the following proposals at the LINC: (a) Construction of an outdoor fitness center near the LINC. The request is for the use of Lincoln University land. Ownership of the land remains with Lincoln University. Jefferson City Parks will cover the cost of the project; and (b) Construction of an outdoor basketball court at the North end at the LINC. Budget and cost is unknown at this time. Costs will be split 50/50 between Lincoln University and Jefferson City Parks. Ownership of the land remains with the University. Curator Popp moved for approval of the recommendation. Curator Callahan seconded the motion. Motion carried. Curator Bradley Brown voted "no" on the motion.

## 6. D. Structural Repairs (Enclosure 7):

Discussion was held on the Campus Structural Assessment. There are five high priority recommendations: (a) Jason Hall - Pedestrian Bridge repair; (b) Elliff Hall - Bowed walls need to be stabilized in JCTV area; (c) Power Plant - Steel column rotted at base and sizeable foundation cracking; (d) Shipping - Load bearing exterior wall has shifted horizontally; and (e) Reed Stadium - Delaminated concrete surfaces and overhead entry point failure. Curator Popp moved for approval of the recommendation to move forward with utilizing Anderson Engineering for the structural designs and construction documents to provide bid documents in the amount of \$255,000. Curator Callahan seconded the motion. Motion carried. Curator Cade abstained from this vote.

1. Increase tuition rates by an estimated 4%. This increase is applicable for all tuition categories.

Rationale for change: Improve opportunity to diversity revenue and increase part-time student population. This change in fee structure will keep the costs for full time students essentially stable. The greatest benefit for this change is the reduced cost of fees for part-time students (students taking from 1-11 credit hours). In addition, this will provide a more transparent flat rate tuition for students taking 12-18 credit hours. Students may incur additional course/lab fees based on the specific course(s) they are registered in.
