



Timely Warning Notice to the Lincoln University Community

ABOUT TIMELY WARNINGS: The purpose of these notices is to inform the university community about significant unsolved crimes and incidents that have come to the attention of the LU Police Department. While these notices are primarily an attempt to increase public awareness, they also serve to dispel myths/rumors about a crime or incident. These notices can be distributed via e-mail, campus mail and fax to campus departments, as well as student organizations, as applicable.

This Notice is in compliance with Title 20 of the United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 1092 (f), commonly known as the "Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act" ("Clery Act"), and the Code of Federal Regulations.

CRIME: Strong-Armed Robbery

DATE & TIME: 11/3/11 & 01:00 - 01:20

LOCATION: Sherman D. Scruggs Parking Lot

DETAILS OF INCIDENT: The Lincoln University Police Department received a report of four to five young black males armed with a semi-automatic handgun robbing a student in Sherman D. Scruggs parking lot. The first suspect was wearing a red Cardinals jacket. He was described as five foot six to five foot eight inches tall wearing a dark skull cap. The second suspect was described as five foot six to five foot eight inches tall wearing a black jacket and dark baseball cap. The third subject was described as five foot ten to six feet tall wearing a dark jacket and a dark baseball cap. All suspects weighed between one hundred and forty pounds to one hundred and sixty pounds. All the subjects fled toward KJLU to Dunklin

St. in a white 2008 to 2010 Chevy Malibu with dark tinted windows.

This timely warning is being issued for the safety of faculty, staff and students at Lincoln University.
