BUSINESS PROGRAM MAINTAINS ACCREDITATION

Jefferson City, MO- The Lincoln University Business program has received notice of reaffirmation of accreditation from the Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP). The program was first accredited by the ACBSP in 2002 and this current notice continues for an additional ten years.

This reaffirmation marks the end of a probation period that was announced in December 2012. It was determined at that time that an electronic transmission error resulted in the university not receiving the ACBSP's original report, which required a response from the university. During the probation period, the university has worked with the ACBSP to provide the necessary responses to the initial report, while continuing the strong tradition of offering quality business instruction to the students of Lincoln University.

In announcing the reaffirmation and other accreditations, ACBSP commended each institution for their commitment to business education. "These campuses have shown their commitment to teaching excellence and to the process of quality improvement by participating in the accreditation process. The initial accreditation and reaffirmation of accreditation granted to these institutions shows their commitment to provide the highest quality business education for their students," said Steve Parscale, ACBSP Director of Accreditation."
