

In this talk, Dr. Endersby will discuss the Lloyd Gaines case and the vital role played by the NAACP as they advanced a concerted strategy to produce political change.

In 1935, Lloyd Gaines' application to the University of Missouri Law School was denied, based solely on the grounds that the state's constitution called for "separate education of the races." Along with the NAACP, Gaines challenged the university's admissions policies in the nation's high court.
